

CIT Successfully Held 2017 Spring Semester HSK & YCT Tests

From Feb.11 to 25,2017, Confucius Institute at Troy University organized and monitored 2017 Spring Semester HSK and YCT tests in three locations. Respectively Chinese Language learners from Confucius Classrooms and teaching sites in Montgomery and Birmingham including Chinese learners Birmingham Chinese School and a few college students from Birmingham and Florida took part in the tests.

Nearly 70 students from Grade 1 to Grade 11 and several college students participated HSK written test from Level 1 to Level 5, YCT written test from Level 1 through Level 4. In addition, students from LAMP High School in Montgomery took HSK Oral Test. What is particularly worth mentioning is that the college students from Florida drove a long way to Troy Campus to engage in HSK Level 5 for an exchange program with Nanjing University in China. In particular, compared to registration of 2016 Fall Semester, 2017 Spring Semester witnessed more fruitful results in learning Chinese, for instance, Chinese learners in Lamp High School and Indian Springs School took the tests ranging from Level 1 to Level 5, in total five distinctive levels enthusiastically.

Under the guidance of CIT director, Dr. Xu, with the hard work and elaborate organization by CIT Chinese instructors, the tests of this season were smoothly and successfully conducted.
