PHASE-OUT OFFERINGS OF
LEARNING CONTRACTS FOR TROY UNIVERSITY'S
MONTGOMERY CAMPUS

Effective fall semester 2007, Troy University will no longer offer 6-month Learning Contracts. Semester Learning contracts may only be offered on the Montgomery Campus if one of the following situations exist:

1. The course is not being offered by any other delivery means during that term or semester.
2. The course is being offered by other delivery means; however, it is not being offered in a Distance Learning format and the student is not within the geographical area to take the course via the delivery format that the course is being offered.
3. The course is being offered in a format that the student could take; however, all the courses are full and University is not willing or able to open a new section or lift the seat capacities to allow the student to register.

If either of the above situations exists, the campus associate dean may approve the Learning Contracts to be offered. Learning Contract courses will not be listed in the Montgomery Campus fall semester course schedule, but will be identified on a list maintained by the associate deans and the Campus Distance Learning Office as back-up options if approved by the associate dean.

The Academic Policies Committee will review the fall data on Learning Contracts and make a recommendation to the EVC/Provost on any future offerings of Learning Contracts for spring semester 2008 and beyond. It is the intention of the EVC/Provost and college deans to discontinue Learning Contracts as a course delivery option after fall semester 2007 unless extenuating circumstances require exceptions beyond that date.
