

## First Group of CNU Students in Troy University Came to Visit CIT

Troy University and Chong Qing Normal University (CNU) launched their full-scale cooperation in 2017. One of the important components of the cooperation is the 1+2+1 program. The first group of CNU students have come to Troy campus in August. In order to promote the deeper cooperation between the two universities, and in order to help these Chinese students adapt to the new environment, Dr. Iris Hong Xu, the director of Confucius Institute at Troy University (CIT), invited the 6 students to visit CIT and have a meeting.
