Program Purpose:

The purpose of the Social Science undergraduate program of study is to provide students with a broad academic exposure to the field of Social Science. Troy University's social science major will prepare you to understand and contribute to society in a meaningful way by applying critical and creative thinking, technology and an interdisciplinary perspective to solving practical problems.

As a student of social science, you will learn to analyze societal issues, identify improvements, and recommend solutions using statistics and data analysis. You'll learn to communicate effectively and to evaluate individual and community needs. As you develop the ability to analyze complex social problems, you will become able to work toward realistic solutions using awareness, acceptance and appreciation of diversity, social factors and global multicultural perspectives.

It may also have interest for CCAF students completing the AAS in **Emergency Management** or **Education Training and Management**.

The BS Degree in Social Science at Troy University **requires:**

1. **45** hours of General Studies classes
2. **36** hours of Social Science Major classes; a core of 15 semester hours of required classes and 21 hours of advisor approved classes selected from **General Social Science**.
3. **18** hours of Minor requirement
4. **21 hours of advisor approved electives**

Please note that CCAF students who have taken Social Science courses in their AAS Program at CCAF may receive transfer credit for equivalent coursework successfully completed. In such cases, the distribution of transfer credits to TROY may be different than is represented.
