

Montgomery Focus – the Workshop of Chinese folk songs

On April. 18, 2018, the seventh workshop of the Chinese Culture Club at the Confucius Institute at Troy University (CIT) Montgomery campus was held in Bartlett Hall with the title of *Chinese folk songs*.

Ms. Zhengqing Cui firstly introduced the "The Book of Songs", the earliest Chinese folk song, which originated more than 3,000 years ago and had a profound influence on the daily life of the working people in that period.
