Servicemembers' Opportunity College Program

As of March 28, 2019, the Department of Defense ended the Servicemembers' Opportunity College Program. Troy University was an affiliate member of the (SOC) network for many years, and TROY has always been part of a group of member institutions selected by the military services to deliver specific associate and bachelor's degree programs to service members and their families. As such, TROY University still provides military students and their adult family members with opportunities to complete college degrees without suffering loss of academic credit due to changes of duty station. TROY offers several degree programs that maximize the use of ACE recommended credits received through the review of a student's military transcripts.
