

Fall 2020 Symphony Band audition procedures

Due to the safety measures surrounding COVID-19 mitigation, we will undertake the following procedures for Symphony Band Auditions. Please note all information subject to change up to and including the time of the auditions.

- Auditions will take place on August 10, 11 in Crosby Theater
- Specific times TBA
- The Band Office will assign each individual an audition time. That time cannot be changed without contacting the Band Office first. Students will not be allowed to show up and audition at any other time other than their assigned time without prior approval.
- No more than 6 students in the hall behind Crosby stage, spaced at 6 foot intervals. Masks are required at all times unless you are auditioning.
- Students will be required to audition on 2 predetermined excerpts, indicated below. There will be no sightreading. Student auditions will take less than 2 minutes each.
- Percussionists will meet with Dr. Blackstock during band camp for percussion-specific details.
- Students will not be allowed to bring their own music into the audition. The Band Office will provide laminated music that will be cleaned between each student.
- Students will dress professionally and be prepared for the audition.
