Hello and Welcome to Troy University Band Summer Camps!

We hope you will consider Troy University your “home away from home” while you are visiting our campus. In this packet, you will find information on what to bring, items you will need for your dorm room, an updated schedule, along with some additional insight into your individual camp.

***Final Performance:** Each camp ends with a final performance highlighting what has been learned over the course of the camp. We encourage you to come support your student as performances are free and open to the public. All performances will take place in Trojan Area (the home of Troy Basketball) at 12:45pm.

***Attire:** Campers should wear comfortable appropriate clothing each day of camp including closed toe and heel shoes. Each student will receive a “Sound of the South” Summer Band Camp shirt. More details can be found inside the packet.

***Check-In Procedures:** Registration will start in the Adams Center in the Trojan Center Ballroom starting at 2:00pm and run through 4:00pm. After a student completes registration, they will be able to move into their dorms. Dorms will be accessible after check-in until 4:15pm at which time all campers are required to attend an opening assembly meeting. We encourage all forms to be filled out in advance when possible and are included in this packet. However, forms will be available at registration. If this is the case, parents are required to attend registration with their student as they are considered minors and forms will need adult signatures. ***Camp Butter and Egg Waiver Directions:** Click “Custom Group Events”—Concert Band Camp should scroll to “Troy University Band Camp #1” and Leadership Camp should scroll to “Troy University Band Camp #2”—students attending both weeks of camp will need to submit separate forms for each event. Once complete, please screenshot receipt of completion and bring to registration.



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***Check-Out/Move Out:** All students are required to check-out of their dorms and move out after each camp. Dorms may change week-to-week depending on what other camps the university is hosting. Students are not permitted to stay in dorms between camps.

***Dorms:** Student campers staying in dorms will be assigned dorms the day of check-in. We will not know specific dorm locations until that day due to the number of camps hosted on campus. Lost keys will incur a \$50 replacement fee. Dorms are separate for girls and boys. Roommates cannot be switched once assigned. Things to bring can be found in the packet.

Parents are not able to pick their student up from camp without prior notification and approval from the band directors. This is done for safety purposes. Commuter students who are picked up daily, will only be picked up from the John M. Long School of Music, not from off campus activities as in past years. Commuter students should also be dropped off at the John M. Long School of Music each morning.

College students assist the directors and clinicians with running the camp and serve as RAs and chaperones for campers. Female college students are assigned to female dorms, and male college students are assigned to male dorms.

If you are uncertain about camp payment status, please direct payment questions to Student Services (334-670-3203). The band office does not have this information available.

We want your student to have an exceptional and memorable time while at Troy University. Please be aware that all campers are expected to hold themselves to a high moral standard and adhere to campus policies. Failure to do so will result in parents being contacted and students being dismissed from camp with no refund.
