## Confucius Institute at Troy University Celebrates 2019 Chinese Spring Festival

### Series III - Chinese Tea Ceremony

On November 28, 2018, Confucius Institute at Troy University (CIT) hosted the Chinese Culture and Education Forum during the International Education Week. The forum invited Dr. Roger Hart, Professor of the Department of History and Geography of Texas Southern University and Dean of the China Research Institute, as the keynote speaker. Visiting scholars from CIT also shared their research findings on Language and Culture.

Dr. Roger Hart delivered the first speech, entitled The Crisis of Sino-US Relations: Seeking the Dominance of Science and Technology. From a scientific perspective, he objectively analyzed the causes and manifestations of the crisis in Sino-US relations from seven aspects and believed that the crisis of Sino-US relations mainly lay in the pursuit of the dominant position of science and technology.

Then, visiting scholars from CIT presented their research findings centering around the theme of “Language and Culture”. Combining with their respective professional background, they introduced their own research in the various fields of cultural sharing, second language acquisition, language learning skills, second language teaching methods, and language and cultural relations and so on. Dr. Flobert Feng and Dr. Iris Hong Xu, the instructors of the visiting scholars of CIT, have given great help and valuable advice to their research. The solid academic foundation, meticulous academic attitude, and rich academic achievements of the visiting scholars at Troy University were highly praised by the participants.
