Purpose/use: Controlled injection of gasses, mostly CO₂ as supercritical fluid and/or ethylene as feed into a 500 mL high-pressure reactor operating at high-temperatures.

The instrument must meet the following minimum specifications:

- The instrument must be able to perform the injections of gases into a Buchiglass
 "Novoclave" Type 3/600 mL, 500 bar, 500 °C high-pressure reactor. This 500 mL metal
 reactor works at pressures as high as 500 bar and temperatures as high as 500 °C.
