

The Office of Institutional Research, Planning, and Effectiveness (IRPE) conducted the Senior Student Survey in Spring 2017. The purpose of this survey is to identify student satisfaction of students that would graduate fall 2016, T1, T2 or T3, with their experiences at Troy University, recognize student development as a result of their Troy University education, and identify areas that need to be improved. Data collected in this survey are used to help the University strengthen its academic programs, better serve the needs of its students, and become more effective and efficient in accomplishing its mission and goals. The survey was administered through the online survey program Qualtrics via email to a group of 6,056 students. The target population was students who would graduate during the fall semester 2016, T1, T2 or T3. After two follow up emails on April 19, 2017 and May 3, 2017, a total of 1,075 responses were received; representing a 17.7% response rate.

Okay, touching on a few concerns. The library is a bit out dated. Printers are sometimes down and I personally think better equipment and a new layout that is inviting for students will increase the number of people that go in there. It is like 20,000 students, if not more, that attend Troy and the library always has a handful in there. Another thing, I do not hate my major I love HR but guidance as far as what to do once I get the degree is low. I changed from a Management degree to HR simply because there was no one to coach me and tell me what I can achieve with this degree. Most companies promote from within. I needed help and that help was never there to find. If I could do it over I would major in Public Relations, a major that I was told Troy does not have. Also, Sorrel College of Business only seems to care for Accountants or RMI students. Where are the Marketing, Human Resource, or Management job fairs? No one has thought to reach out to companies to try to expand the other existing majors in business? There are no internship programs specific to those fields that are offered either. This is very poor for a school that puts Bibb Graves building at the center of the college and not treat the people who are taking courses in Bibb the right way. As far as on campus activities, I feel That the school has poor advertising for sports or other events. I received word of basketball games, and other sports excluding football mostly through word of mouth. Yes I know the university puts signs up, but those signs are often ignored and are not a focal point for attention. Also the commuter flex points are relatively low. I am an older student, and navigating through the system was kind of frustrating. People I called to help at the school had attitudes and they seemed as though it was a bother to them to help me, like I should already know how to do this.

I am happy this is over. I had one professor over the last three years that actually cared. The rest showed that the check cleared. I had almost no guidance in the academic process and I have no idea what I have to do to move on to a masters program. I can guarantee it will not be a masters program at Troy. The school continually says these are not correspondence courses. I took correspondence courses before there were online courses. This IS a correspondence degree. Your professors have to learn how to utilize the online environment to run a virtual class of some type. I had one professor that did that in three years!

Parking passes for the Dothan campus are seemingly nonessential. There is no issue with parking at this campus, and if it is an issue of safety, why should we have to pay \$75 to be safe? I think decals should come at a lesser cost for satellite campuses.

Also, Dr. Jeneve Brooks is a true highlight of the Dothan Campus. She is a wonderful, encouraging, and insightful professor. She made my time at Troy-Dothan very special and fulfilling.

Troy University should focus on expanding (buildings, parking, etc.) if they wish to continue to increase in number of students.




