

The Office of Institutional Research, Planning, and Effectiveness (IRPE) conducted the New Student Survey in spring 2019. The purpose of the survey was to identify the satisfaction of the fall 2018, T1,T2 and T3 new students with their experiences at Troy University and to determine how well the University served their needs as new undergraduate students. The survey was administered through the online survey program Qualtrics via email to a group of 4,174 students. The target population was the new students who enrolled at the University for the first time during the fall semester, T1, T2 and T3 in 2018. After two follow up emails, on February 4, 2019 and March 19, 2019, a total of 464 responses were received; representing a 11% response rate.





I have had three academic advisers during my time at Troy's Dothan campus, and each one was helpful, insightful, and made their office times clear.


My advisor has been a great help!!

Additional comments about your experience as a new student at Troy University:

Troy online has been a great all around experience for me. I'm so thankful for the opportunity to complete my degree online.

I feel like I am drowning with the technology. I have to use livetext which is extremely difficult. I was given no training on this. As a woman in her 50's, I have no trouble whatsoever with the academic content. I often struggle with the ways I am to deliver my information. I don't know where I am to go with this. Since I am already not attending physical classes, why can there not be a video that would explain some things? I am having to check You Tube to get trained on things randomly that I believe Troy could be proactive about for the online students. I notice that lots of the students do an immediate turn around-bachelor's to master's. However that does not cover the demographics of all your online students.

I was anxious when I first started, but the pace of the courses are challenging yet manageable and the instructors are willing to help answer any questions. It's been a very good experience so far and I can't wait to continue to learn. I've already been able to apply skills learned in class to my job and career goals.

Overall, it has been a wonderful experience. Sometimes it is a little frustrating being an online-only student but I have found that when I reach out to the right people they are prompt and caring in looking into my requests and/or issues.

Enrollment was extremely easy and they provided me with step by step instructions to successfully enroll and helped make my financial aid easy to apply for and understand

As with any school, there are some really great online professors and then there are some very poor ones. In the two terms I have completed I have had a 50/50 result on good online professors and ones that were either unorganized or MIA. With online courses, you need an instructor that is very well organized when posting assignments and due dates, as well as descriptive when explaining assignments. But overall, this is getting the job done.

Last semester I felt very left out of my online class. On our discussion posts, 98% of the class posted their discussions the last 30 minutes before the time ran out. I did not receive hardly any responses to my posts. Even the professor barely responded to me,(maybe a half sentence to my posts) but he responded with several paragraphs to the late discussion posts.
