

The Office of Institutional Research, Planning, and Effectiveness (IRPE) conducted the Senior Student Survey in spring 2020. The purpose of this survey is to identify student satisfaction of students that would graduate fall 2019, T1, T2 or T3, with their experiences at Troy University, recognize student development as a result of their Troy University education, and identify areas that need to be improved. Data collected in this survey are used to help the University strengthen its academic programs, better serve the needs of its students, and become more effective and efficient in accomplishing its mission and goals. The survey was administered through the online survey program Qualtrics via email to a group of 2,156 students. The target population was students who would graduate during the fall semester 2019, T1, T2 or T3. After two follow up emails on April 28, 2020 and May 14, 2020, a total of 332 responses were received; representing a 15.4% response rate


From which Troy University campus will you graduate?




What degree program are you currently completing at Troy University?

My experience at Troy University helped me to overcome the anxiety of returning to school. The courses were challenging but providing the material needed to build the confidence in grasping the subject.

Student government was a huge disappointment at the Troy Dothan campus. Sandy Henry and her receptionist, Charlene Owens (who is also a student and clerk in the SGA), make all executive decisions without consulting other members, which defeats the purpose of a student organization. There is a HUGE conflict of interest and abuse of power going on in this area that is obvious because both the president and Vice President resigned because of their actions this last year (2019-2020).

The interpreter training program is a disaster and the department heads are extremely unorganized and terrible at communicating with students. Materials and class content posted on Canvas are outdated (especially for practicum and internship) and staff couldn't be bothered to update them.






