

The Office of Institutional Research, Planning, and Effectiveness (IRPE) conducted the New Student Survey in spring 2022. The purpose of the survey was to identify the satisfaction of the fall 2021, T1,T2 and T3 new students with their experiences at Troy University and to determine how well the University served their needs as new undergraduate students. The survey was administered through the online survey program Qualtrics via email to a group of 5,289 students. The target population was the new students who enrolled at the University for the first time during the fall semester, T1, T2 and T3 in 2024. After two follow up emails, on April 26, 2022 and May 3, 2022, a total of 370 responses were received; representing a 7% response rate.


Gender



Ethnicity








First-Generation Status: Did the parent(s) with whom you reside/resided receive a baccalaureate degree from a college or university?

Which Troy University campus are you currently enrolled?





Social Work advisor incredibly empathetic and tenacious.

My academic advising was great but this semester has been one of my worst of my collegiate career. The instructor I felt was very unreasonable. They forgot the start date of our class and the expectations that were places with course work is unmanagable. I have been to three differnt colleges and this was by far my worst experience I have ever had.

Honestly, I hate to voice complaints, however, I know someone had to speak up in order for improvement to happen. After completing my application for RN to BSN mobility program I received an automated acceptance email from Ms. Crystal Bishop with program info and instructions. I had some questions so I reached out to Ms. Gowin via email and phone on several occasions. Most attempts at contacting her resulted in an email response several days after the attempt. I submitted official transcripts several times and it took her quite some time to view my transcripts and tell me which classes I need to take at troy to complete my BSN. When she finally did review the transcript that I had sent multiple times, she emailed me a list of classes she says I needed to take. I was a bit confused because 1 of the courses she had listed was on my transcript. I questioned this and she reviewed them again and agreed the class was not needed as I had already taken it. I take this very seriously considering I am paying for my education. This was memorable for me because during this time our interactions or lack thereof caused me to question enrolling into troy. This was my initial contact person at troy and honestly i felt that my education was insignificant to her and me me getting registered was not a priority of hers. This concerned me because I had been informed that as a mobility major I could not register unless she okayed me to do so. So my initial impression of troy was not good. I can only hope the process for incoming new college students is better. Due to my having been to college I was able to advocate for myself and seek out information for myself. I also received several different start dates for the RN to BSN program. This was very confusing. However at some point during my process of trying to get into troy I was connected with Ms. Kelly Sneed Johnson and I must say she was amazing and assisted me in any and every way she could. She was very knowledgeable about the program and was ready and willing to answer all of my questions. This experience with her aided in getting rid of my fears about going to troy. I had begun to think If this individual is any indication of how this school and program are Im not certain if I want to attend. Ms. Johnson is amazing and the University should be proud to have someone like her who truly care about the education of the students. She even messages me at the end of Term four and offered to assist me with registration if needed. The review above reflects the performance of Ms. Kelly Johnson.

As stated before, Mr. Martin has been amazing. He has been attentive and helpful with every question I have asked him. My situation is different due to my location in the military and being on a base that has no access to going off base. He has aided me in so many things and is amazing at his job.

It would be helpful to talk to them more, versus getting what seems like scripted/automated emails. When talking about the things that were happening in my personal life that affected my education, she listened, but didn't seem to really care/understand the gravity of it all because that was the first time I have ever talked to her on the phone. I have had the same Academic Advisor since mid 2019, and the first time I talked to her on the phone was in March of 2022, when I was placed on academic suspension due to the family matters I had.

My academic advising experience was very unpleasant. When I told my concerns, I felt uncomfortable because of the lack of enthusiasm and caring. Negative energy and attitude was given to me when I I was trying to have positive energy and interaction.

Clayton graham is my advisor and has been incredibly helpful from the beginning. Much more than other schools i have attended.

My academic advisor is literally the BEST person ever. She honestly does more than she probably is assigned too. Mrs. Howe made me feel so comfortable. I am a transfer student from The University of Alabama and after two months of being here I had already re-applied to transfer back because i felt this was NOT the school for me though it was closer to home something I wanted. After speaking with her and telling her that my grades were poor, and how lonely I feel and that I never left my room really except for class she literally made me feel 10 times better and I decided not to transfer back and I will be doing summer classes to better my GPA and help with the classes I did not do well in. I feel that all of the academic advisors are not on the same page. Different advisors tell students different things. There have been several occasions where I have received false information from an advisor. Everything's fine so far, but it is pretty early in my experience. Online classes are a very different experience than my prior time in college, and they take some getting used to, as well as a general inconsistency among them in how they operate and what to expect, which is an extra challenging element.

Financial aid needs work. The individuals who work in that department are so dismissive towards the students. When I submitted my application for FAFSA and completed all of my financial aid documents, I received an email stating they would contact me via email for anything needed to complete financial aid requirements. So over the first few weeks before school started I would call at least twice a week to check on the status of my financial aid. Each time the individual I spoke with would just say don't worry about it it will come through just give it some time to process. This continued until school began and it was getting closer to the tuition payment deadline. Then she says well go check and see if you submitted the correct year FAFSA. This was so upsetting to me because I had been calling for weeks to check on the status and was simply told don't worry about it. But no one ever thought to ask if I had submitted the correct year. There is absolutely no support or guidance for new or returning students who have gotten out of the swing of college. Then the second thing that really raised concern about the financial aid office. So after submitting the correct year FAFSA the school needed some type of verification for my financial aid to be granted. I never received an email or anything about this nor was anything on my profile. I called them for 2 days, and also left messages. No one responded so I took it upon myself just to go to campus and check on the status of my financial aid. I get there and I am informed that you need to verify, I was spoken to in a very dismissive tone and handed a piece of paper and told to bring it back. So I read the paper and it stated I could verify using my transcripts. I told the lady at the desk that I had submitted a transcript when I applied for troy and asked her If I could just check that option, sign the form, and if she could verify using the official transcripts that I submitted to apply. She stated yes. I was just dumbfounded because I have never experienced a school financial aid office care as little as the Troy Dothan campus financial aid did about a new student trying to complete financial aid requirements. Oh and once they get used to you on the caller I.D. they no longer answer your calls. I suspected this was happening towards the end of this ordeal and decided to call financial aid office from outside the office, and just as I suspected they did not answer my calls. So from that point on I simply drove to troy to check on the status of my aid. The Registration and recruiting offices were amazing and had excellent, kind, and helpful staff.

Thank you for everything. I am hoping to finish my BSW and go straight into getting my MSW. You guys rock. Keep it up.

I feel as if I cannot walk alone anywhere and that my overall health is generally not cared about from most of the faculty. Some of the professors are predatory and generally uncomfortable to be around and make it hard to enjoy college entirely. I should not have to worry about walking into class and being approached by my professor in a way that would make anyone uncomfortable.

Troy University must improve their campus and curriculum a great deal. There are many many things to be worked on before I would even recommend a friend, let alone family, to attend this school.
