

The Office of Institutional Research, Planning, and Effectiveness (IRPE) conducted the Senior Student Survey in spring 2024. The purpose of this survey is to identify student satisfaction of students that would graduate fall 2023, T1, T2 or T3, with their experiences at Troy University, recognize student development as a result of their Troy University education, and identify areas that need to be improved. Data collected in this survey are used to help the University strengthen its academic programs, better serve the needs of its students, and become more effective and efficient in accomplishing its mission and goals. The survey was administered through the online survey program Qualtrics via email to a group of 1,268 students. The target population was students who would graduate during the fall semester 2023, T1, T2 or T3. After two follow up emails on April 24, 2024 and May 5, 2024, a total of 179 responses were received; representing a 14% response rate.

It was a little overwhelming at first because there was a lot of information reviewed in a short amount of time in pharm and patho. I wish that those classes could have been spread out over 2 semesters. I have nothing but great things to say about the program overall though. The teachers are very helpful.

I think there should be more prioritizing for clinical development as an advanced provider. Provide more detail for advanced clinical assessment skills, managing a patient, etc.

Needs more funding, attention, care, growth.

Every exam throughout the program should mirror the same style to reduce inconsistent grading amongst dissimilar instructors and classes and to adequately and efficiently prepare for the NCLEX. Students should be taught precisely how the NCLEX scoring system works in semester one rather than learning essential strategies in the fifth semester during the 3-day NCLEX Review. These valuable strategies include dissecting the questions and answers accurately, how the question will be evaluated, and determining if partial credit applies or doesn't. More exposure to Next-Gen style questions and opportunities to enhance our familiarity with them is needed. Rather than only being exposed to them when taking exams, present more in class, on quizzes between exams, and include them in assignments so there are more opportunities for feedback when struggling.

This forward-thinking approach suggests that early exposure to consistent Next-Gen/NCLEX-style questions would allow students to understand how to maximize their scores from the beginning, thereby aligning our curriculum with the evolving trends in nursing education.

It was good just needed more professor to allow a better variety of classes.







Graduate online program, FNP a lot of the questions did not apply as I was not on campus

It is a great school with wonderful teachers.

I rated the campus as dissatisfactory. The low-income housing attached to the nursing building has been a source of discomfort and distraction on more than one occasion. Tenants' loitering, fighting, and soliciting have recurrently interfered with maintaining an ideal environment conducive to learning, listening to lectures held in the building, and demonstrating and rehearsing lab activities such as checkoffs. This program and the activities as mentioned above are exceptionally high-pressure. Time on campus is sometimes diminished due to the frustrating and uncomfortable tenant behaviors and various occurrences outside the building.

I have enjoyed my time at Troy University and feel well prepared.

There needs to be more accountability for administrators and professors making mistakes that negatively impact students. My graduation was delayed by 6 months because I was left off of an email list for practicum information, and nobody told me about the mandatory meeting until a professors asked me a month later why I wasn't there. This leads to the RSA grant paying for an extra semester, in turn leading to me having to work off my debt for another year in a field that I was coerced into joining. The quality of instruction is more than adequate, but the accountability is SEVERELY lacking.

There are many classes that are only offered in certain semesters and only have one time frame. Alot of important classes are all slotted for T Th at 11:00 and I've had semesters where that's the only class I had on that day and had to structure my other classes around that time frame.


