

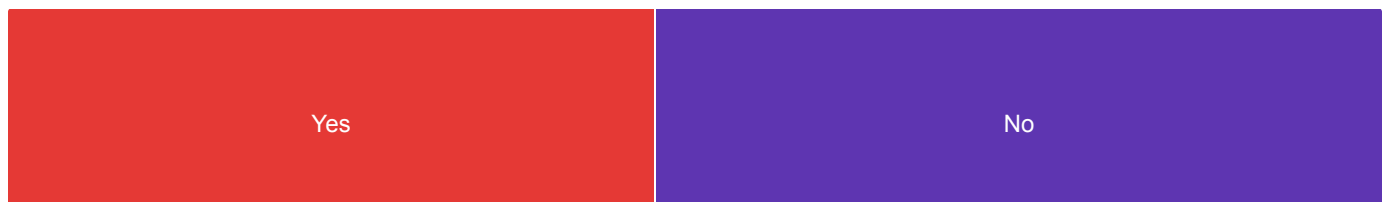

2025 New Student Survey Report

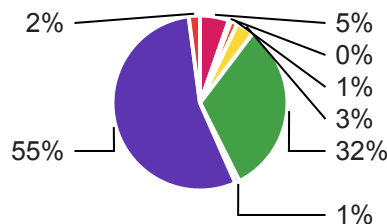
The Office of Institutional Research, Planning, and Effectiveness (IRPE) conducted the New Student Survey in spring 2025. The purpose of the survey was to identify the satisfaction of the fall 2024, T1, T2 and T3 new students with their experiences at Troy University and to determine how well the University served their needs as new undergraduate students. The survey was administered through the online survey program Qualtrics via email to a group of 4,053 students. The target population was the new students who enrolled at the University for the first time during the fall semester, T1, T2 and T3 in 2024. After two follow up emails, on April 28, 2025 and May 5, 2025, a total of 273 responses were received; representing a 7% response rate.

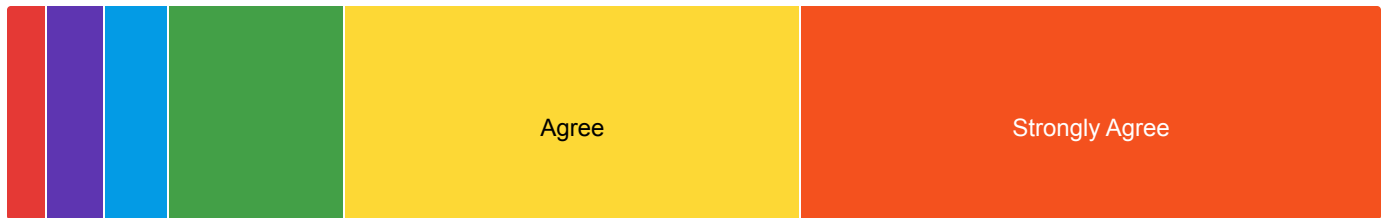

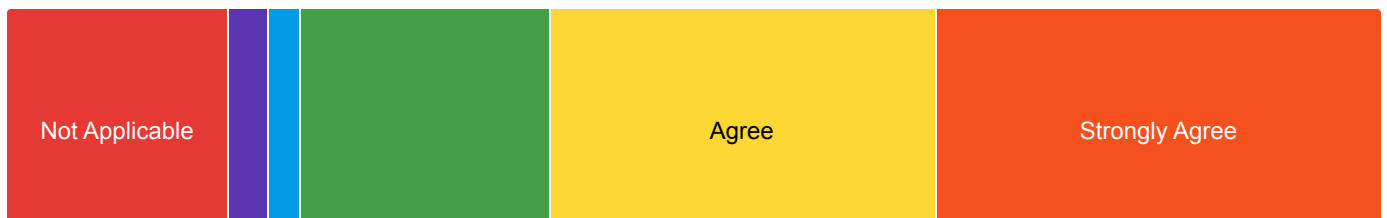

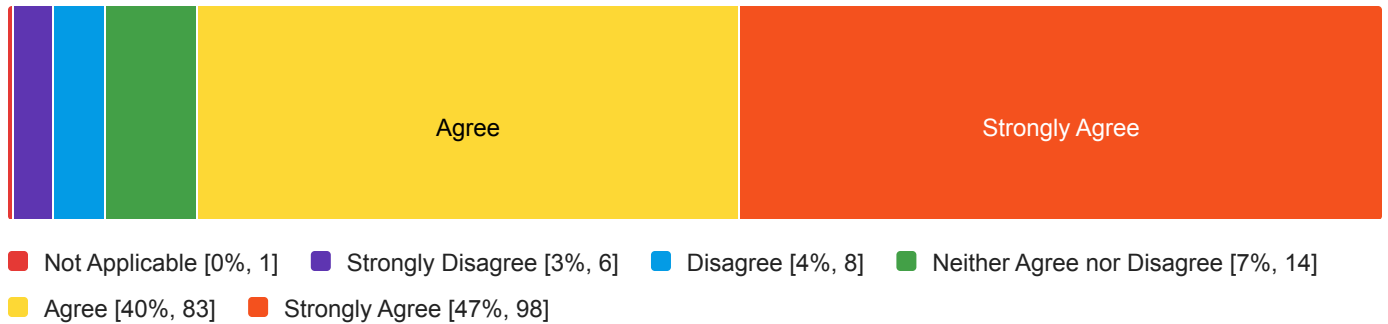

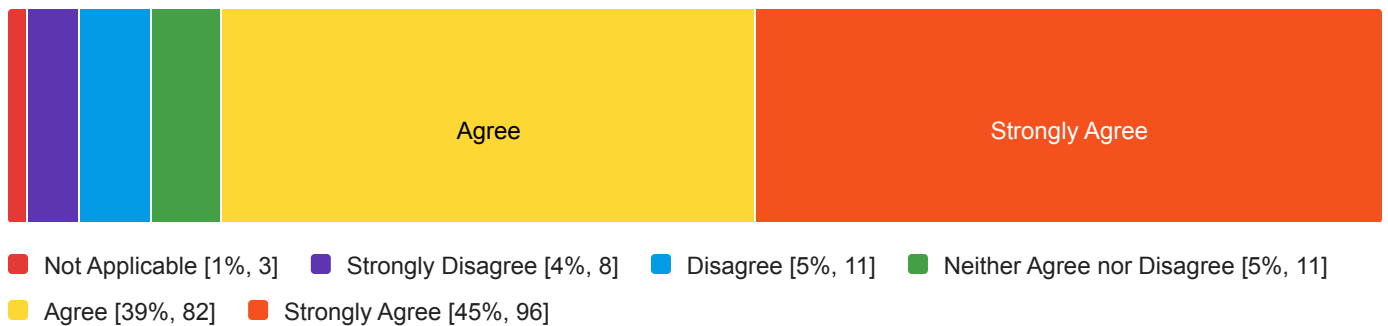

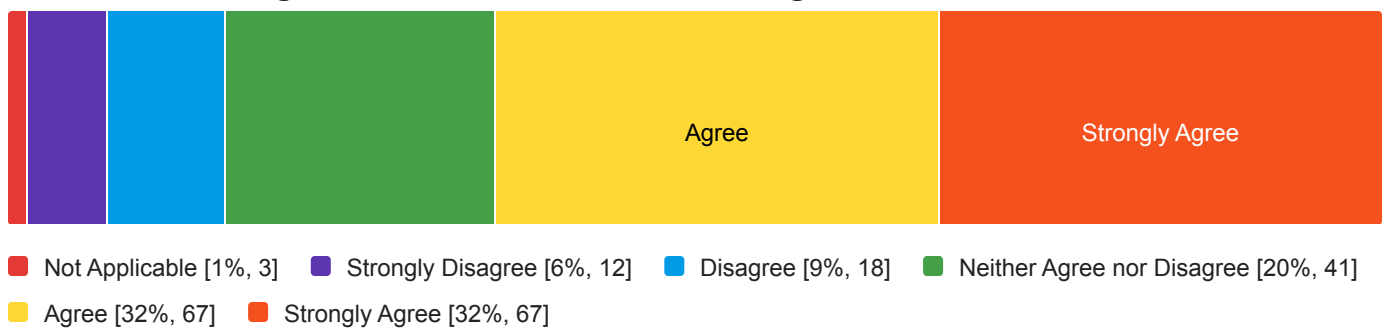
Registration dates, times, and procedures were made clear to me prior to enrollment

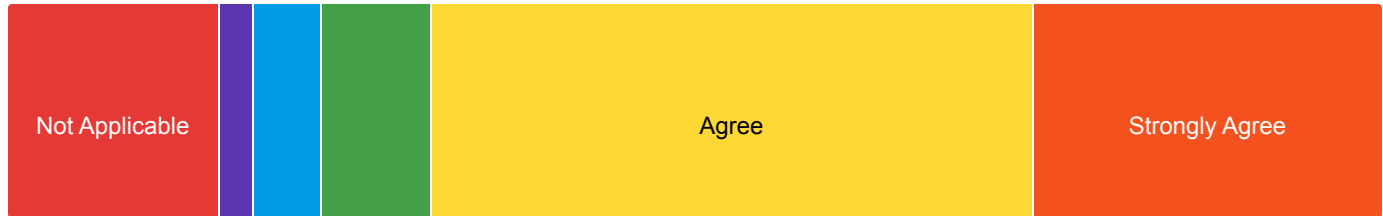

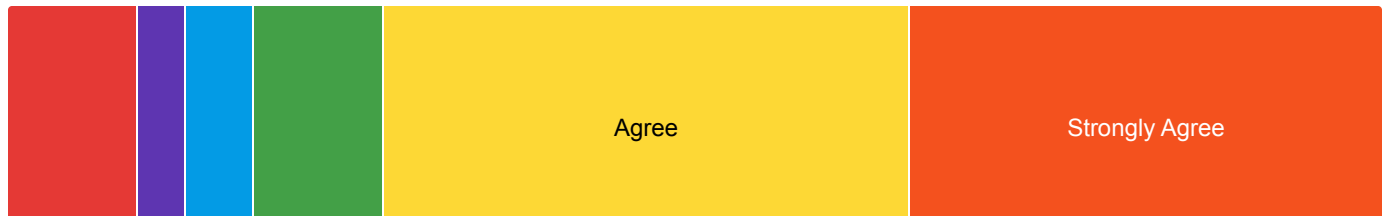

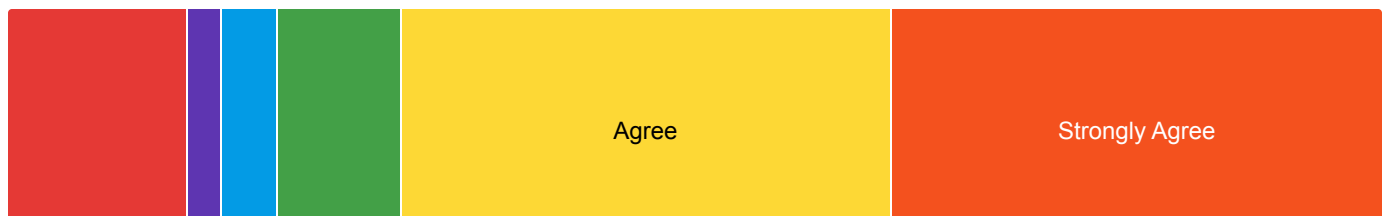

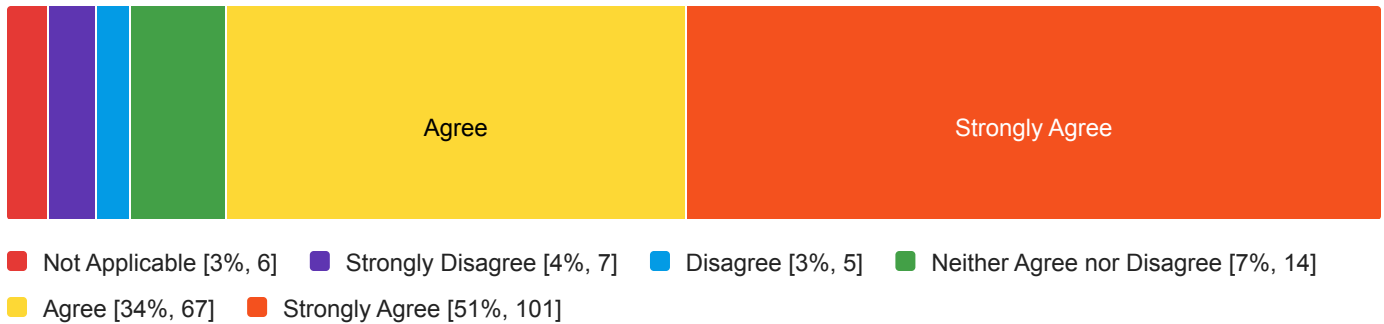

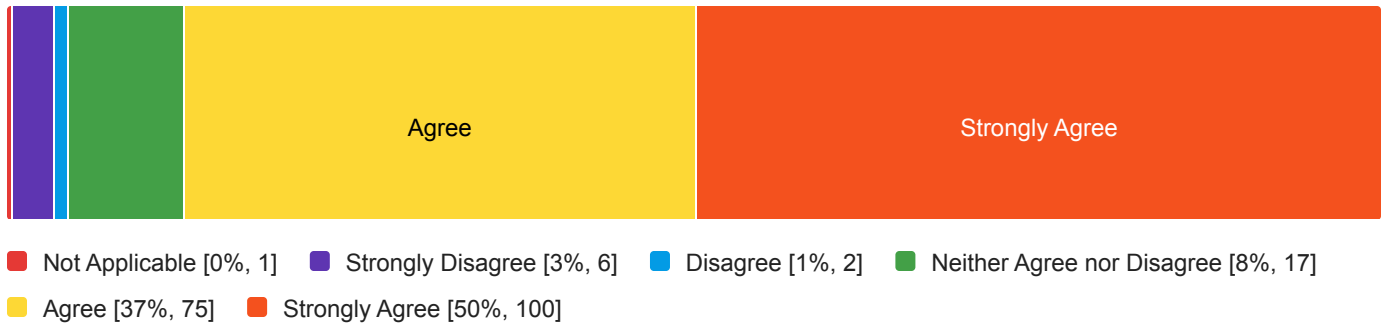

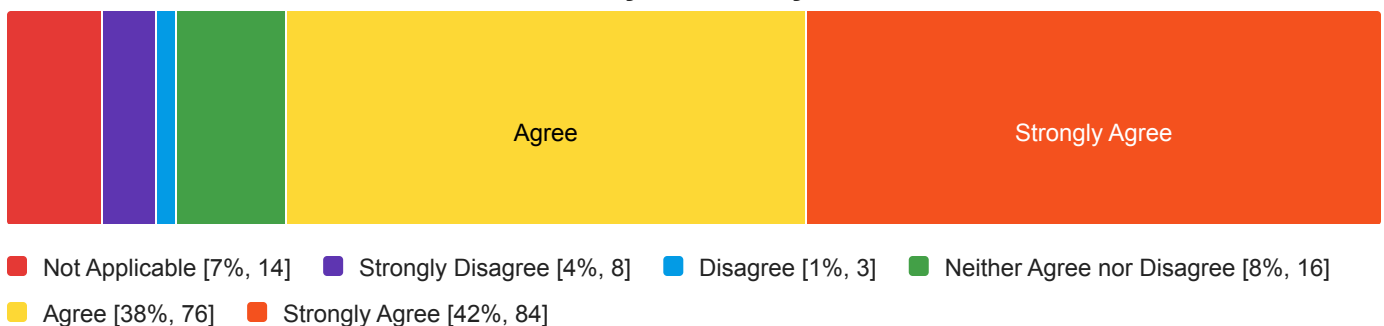

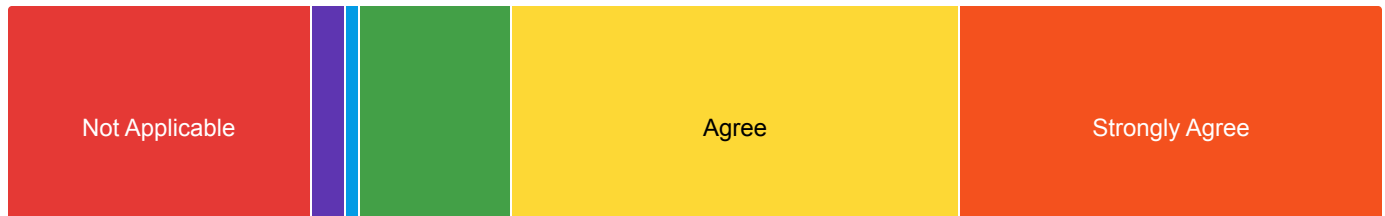


Campus housing met my expectations upon arriving to campus



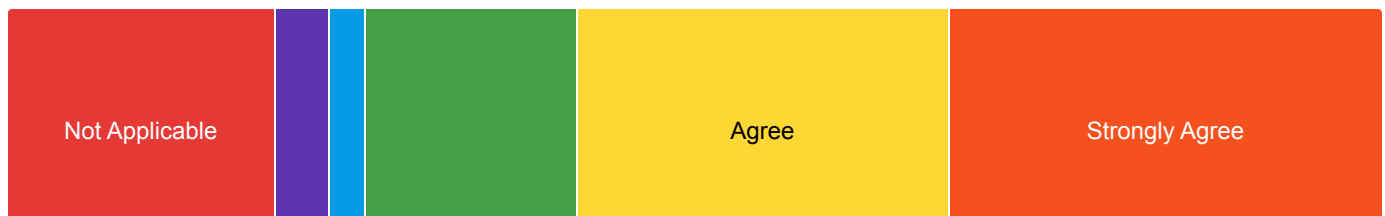

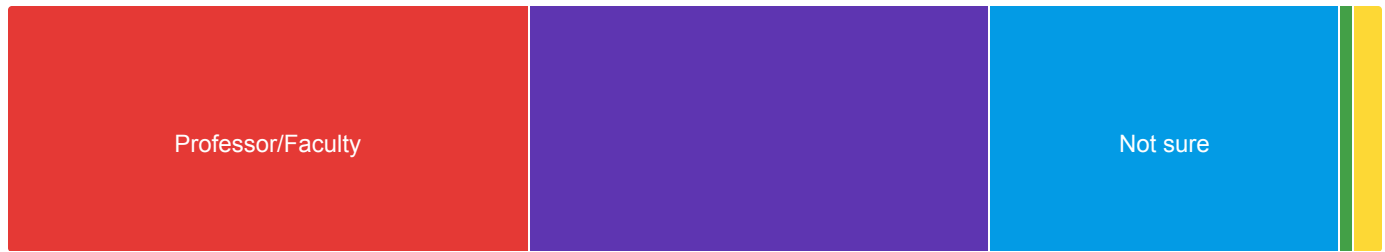

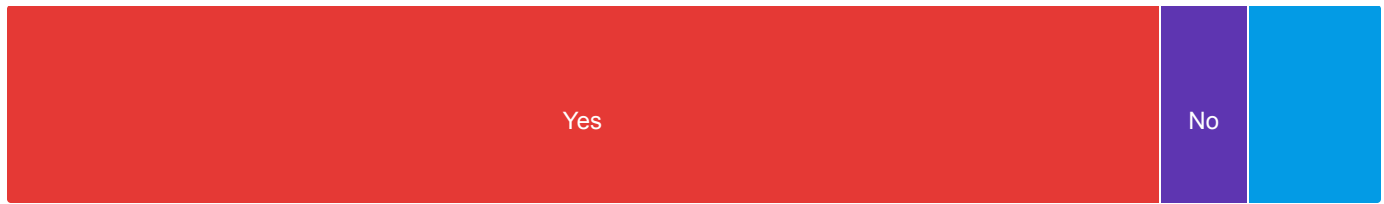

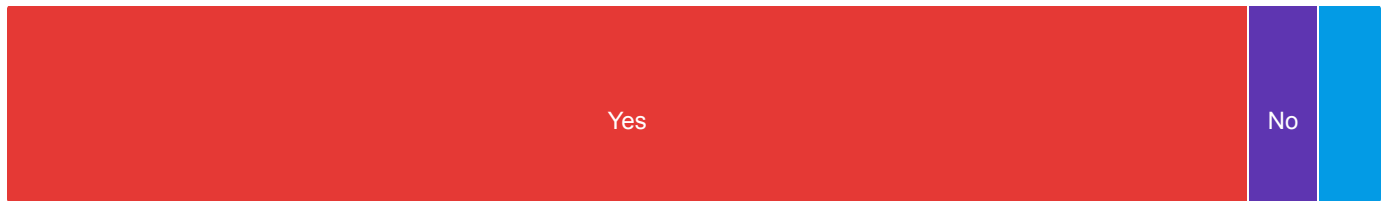

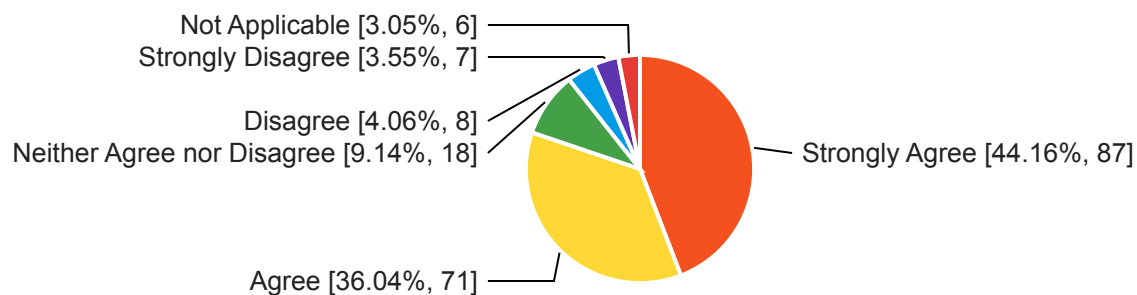

If you have been assigned an academic advisor, did you have any contact with your advisor during your first semester/term at TROY?



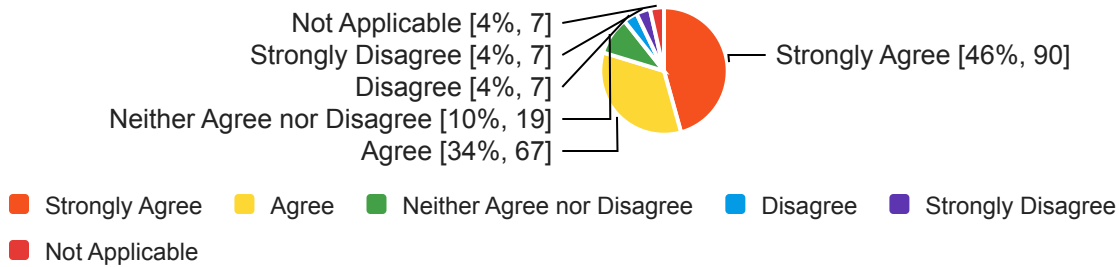

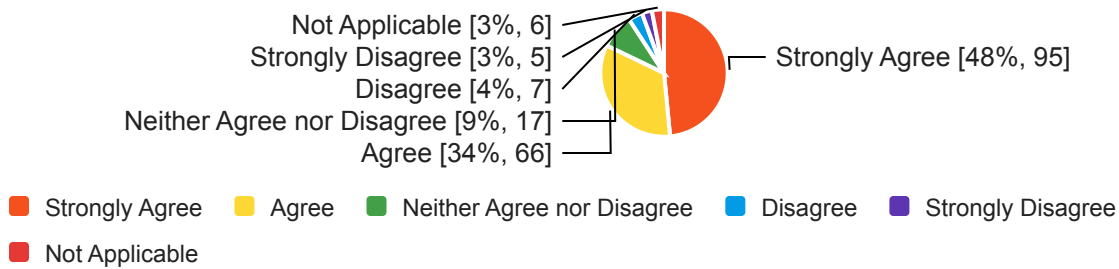

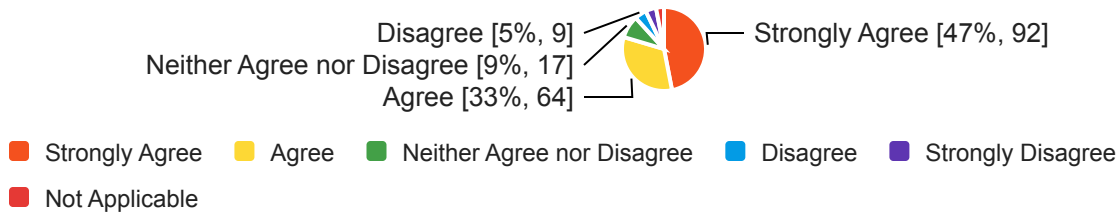
My academic advisor is helpful in scheduling my classes



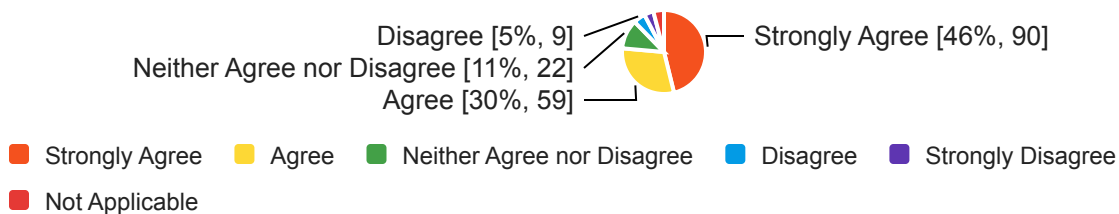
My academic advisor is helpful in the registration process



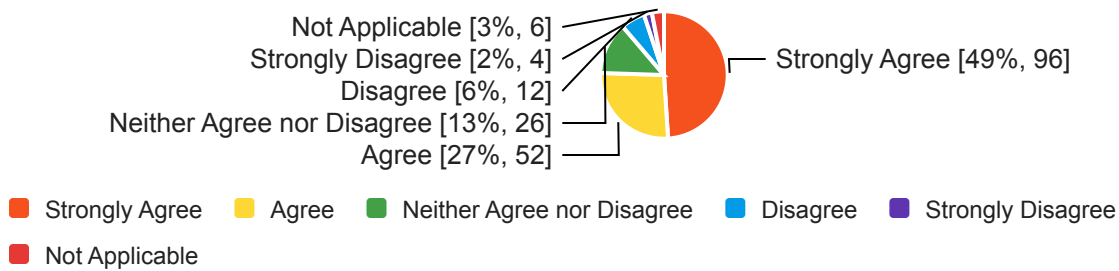
My academic advisor provides accurate info about my major and my program requirements



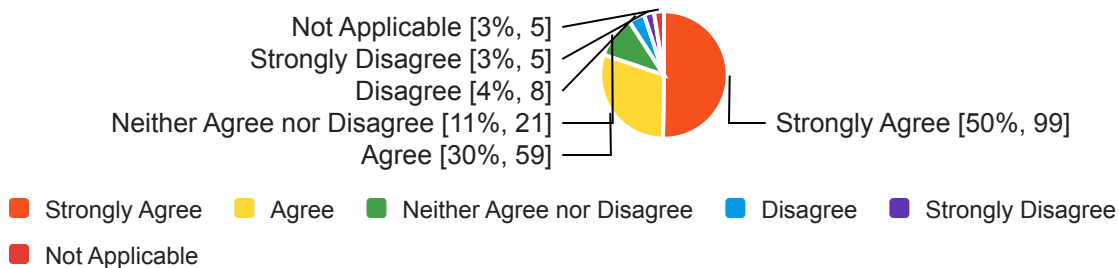

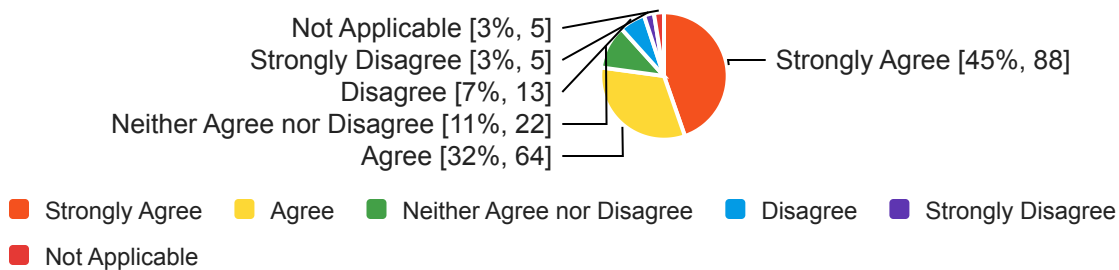

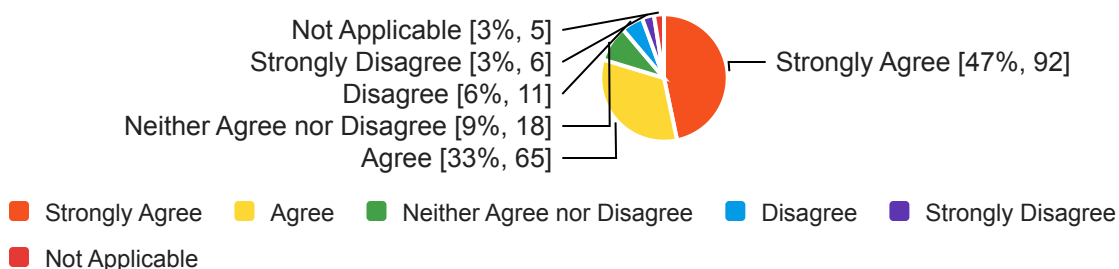

The academic advising process at Troy University adequately meets my needs

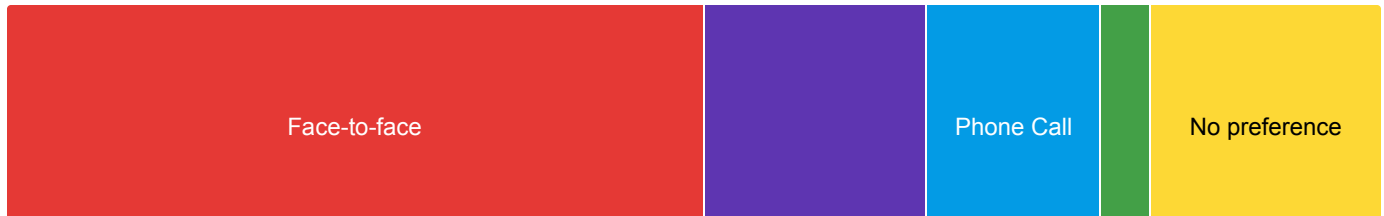
