

The Office of Institutional Research, Planning, and Effectiveness (IRPE) conducted the Senior Student Survey in spring 2025. The purpose of this survey is to identify student satisfaction of students that would graduate fall 2024, T1, T2 or T3, with their experiences at Troy University, recognize student development as a result of their Troy University education, and identify areas that need to be improved. Data collected in this survey are used to help the University strengthen its academic programs, better serve the needs of its students, and become more effective and efficient in accomplishing its mission and goals. The survey was administered through the online survey program Qualtrics via email to a group of 1,268 students. The target population was students who would graduate during the fall semester 2024, T1, T2 or T3. After two follow up emails on April 24, 2025 and May 5, 2025, a total of 261 responses were received; representing a 21% response rate.

More scholarship opportunities would have been beneficial as well.

This program is amazing. I love that it offers the student PMI account which is fundamental in starting your career out as a project manager. I also love that the capstone course offers a passing grade upon earning your project management certification. You would automatically get an a in the class. To me that is amazing because it shows that if you can master that certification, then you have mastered, you have essentially completed the capstone you master project management. One thing I will say is I would love for the program to offer double majors for example I would love for the program to allow for someone to earn masters and management in project management and leadership. That will be awesome as well.

The degrees I am graduating in is not something I want to do because of the job market in those fields. However, I was able to add a minor and this is the more likely the career field I want to chase.


To have more specialties


The KHP department is the best! Wonderful professors who push their students to be great.

The program enlightened me on some of my responsibilities in my current role, and it developed and enhanced my skills.




How would you rate Troy University's preparation of you for employment?






