Program Purpose:

The purpose of the human services major is twofold: (1) to prepare the graduate for entry level positions in a myriad of human services delivery systems where specialized training is not required, and (2) to prepare students for graduate education. The curriculum is designed to provide the student with an understanding of human behavior within the context of the social environment, an understanding of social and human service delivery systems, and basic skills in effective communication with client systems and basic skills in the development of intervention strategies to resolve interpersonal and social problems.

The BS Degree in Human Services at Troy University **requires:** (the first 60 semester hours of this program will be completed at Coastline Community College, CA. The balance of the program will be completed through [Troy ONLINE](#))

1. **45** hours of General Studies classes
2. **36** hours of Human Services Major classes; a core of 24 semester hours of required classes and 12 hours of advisor approved classes selected from Human Services, Rehabilitation or Social Work.
3. **18** hours of Minor requirement
4. **21** hours of advisor approved electives
