AP Biology	None	<i>Provided by Student-Variou Household Materials</i>	<p>The following lab materials are necessary to complete the course:</p> <p>Segment One Required Lab Materials Lesson 1.03: 125 light-colored beans and 50 dark-colored beans (or you can use two colors of candy), Calculator Graph Paper. Lesson 2.03: 6 large plastic cups or bowls, Aluminum foil, or plastic wrap, Knife (to cut the potato/fruit) Metric ruler, Paper towel, 2 water-tight Zip-lock plastic sandwich bags, Measuring cups and spoons, 1 potato, your choice of one of the following: sweet potato, pear, or apple, 60 g or 5 tablespoons (Tbs.) sucrose (table sugar), 100 mL distilled water (from the grocery store) Iodine (can be obtained at a discount or drug store), Starch solution, (Options for creating solution): Option 1. Add 1/4 cup cornstarch and 1/4 cup water into a bowl. Stir to mix. Add 1 to 1 1/2 cups very warm water (Be very careful when working with hot water), stir well. Option 2. Boil a small potato in 1 cup of water, and then mash the potato. After the potato cools, pour water over the mashed potato and strain the fibrous part out using a coffee filter. Cool to room temperature to avoid adding temperature as a variable.
