Academic Regulations Section, Placement in Academic Courses

Effective Fall 2015:

Placement in Academic Courses

A student may be placed in an advanced section of a given subject area if the student's record indicates a high degree of achievement or if it indicates the student has successfully completed studies that should not be duplicated. Troy University does not accept placement exemptions granted by other institutions. For more information, students should consult their academic advisers and/or the respective academic departments.

ACT (English): with ACT (English) score of 30-34, student will receive three hours credit for ENG 1101.

ACT (English): with ACT (English) score of 35-36, student will receive six hours credit for ENG 1101 and ENG 1102.

SAT (Verbal): with SAT (Verbal) score of 680-710, student will receive three hours credit for ENG 1101.

SAT (Verbal): with SAT (Verbal) score of at least 720, student will receive six hours credit for ENG 1101 and ENG 1102.
