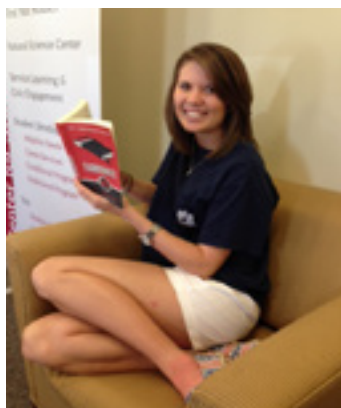

Common Reading Initiative Spotlights Fahrenheit 451 by Ray Bradbury

Every year the University focuses on one book, required for all entering freshmen, that we hope challenges the students and inspires them in some way. This year's selection is Fahrenheit 451 by Ray Bradbury. This novel written in 1953 describes a futuristic account of an American society in which reading and owning books is outlawed. The lead character in the story is a fireman named Guy Montag. Montag's job is not to put out fires but to start fires. After burning books and homes, Guy questions his life and his world view. We hope this story will get students interested in reading and learning about something new. This book is a required reading for the Troy 1101 Orientation class that all freshman students take their first year at Troy.
