Troy U Top Ways for Parents To Stay Informed

Here are several ways for you to keep up with what is going on this semester while your student is enrolled at Troy University. Staying connected and communicating with you is one of the elements that we find most helpful to students and we strive to make that a priority. One way we do that is using this parent newsletter. Thank you for being apart of that. Here are some communication components to keep you informed. **1) TROJAN ONE STOP-** This site is created to be a one stop shop to view any upcoming deadlines or important happenings for registration, graduation, financial aid, or admissions. **2) SOS Emergency Alert-** This is an alert system for a student to be notified via text or e-mail of any unexpected events, including: Emergency Broadcasts, Emergency Alerts, Weather Advisories, or School Closings. A student can sign a parent up by visiting <http://sos.troy.edu/subscribe.html>. **3) Ask@troy.edu-** Do you have a question but not sure who to ask or where to start? Ask@troy.edu is an e-mail address that's monitored regularly to route your questions to the correct place. Just include your question, your student's name, Student I.D # and your contact info. **Note:** Please be sure that if you wish to speak to someone about your son or daughter that you and your student have signed a Parent Consent Form so that a Troy staff member can legally discuss any information regarding your student. **4) Come join the fun!** Many parents take part in joining in on their son or daughter's college experience....and FALL is the perfect time!
