



2016 China Trip for Troy University Professors and Students

What: The Confucius Institute at Troy University is to host its 8th year trip to China this upcoming summer, 2016. CIT has supported more than 400 Alabamians to visit China since 2009, including government officials, professors, educators, musicians, artists, artwork, entrepreneurs, business developers, students, dancing groups, nursing groups, and business owners.

Who: All students and Troy University full-time faculty are eligible to participate.

Where: We will visit key education institutions and places of interests in Beijing, Tianjin, and Xi'an that will be of interest to the participants.

When: May 15th – May 27th, 2016.

Why: China is a dynamic country with many opportunities to enhance your career choices, and a visit now will allow you to witness in person how progress and development are giving China such a dramatic face lift. Plans are to Beijing and Xi'an, along with Hanban (Ministry of Education).

Financial support: Given the funding support by CI, arrangements to participate need to be made soon as there are only a limited number of students and faculty who can be supported. All in-China lodging, meals and travel expenses---except tips \$100 and your personal expenditure.
