

A Brief Introduction to Chongqing Normal University

Chongqing Normal University (hereafter as “CNU”), founded in 1954, is a full-time comprehensive institution of higher education under the leadership of Chongqing Municipal Government of P. R. China. CNU covers over 190 hectares (2800 mu) and is located in Shapingba District, the cultural and educational district of Chongqing. CNU is a higher education institution authorized to award Master’s and Bachelor’s degree with the approval of the Degree Awarding commission of the State Council, P. R. China. Currently, there are 17 colleges, 67 bachelor’s degree programs, 17 first-level discipline of authorized master’s degree programs, 10 professional authorized master degree programs, authorized secondary vocational master’s degree, authorized advanced teachers professional master degree of literature, science, economics, management, art, physical education, etc., forming an educational system which is able to train postgraduates, undergraduates, associates and overseas students. Currently, there are over 29,400 full time students and over 1700 teachers including more than 700 professors and associate professors.

CNU is entitled by the Ministry of Education, P.R. China to recruit overseas students. It was designated as one of the first Chinese Language Educational Centres by the Overseas Chinese Affairs Office of the State Council. And it was awarded the National Teaching Base for International Promotion of Chinese (Chongqing) by Confucius Institute Headquarters in 2012. The university, featured in teachers’ education, has developed into a higher education institution of multi-subjects involving science and liberal arts. A fairly complete teachers’ education system has been formed including pre-school education, primary school education, middle school education, higher education, continuing education, vocational and technical education, special education, and teachers training for Chinese language and culture education.

Grasping the tendency of educational globalization, CNU perseveres in the mode of “open university”. The university has successively established cooperation and exchange relationship with education institutions in over 20 countries such as UK, USA, Russia, Canada, Australia, Sweden, Japan, South Korea, Hungary, Malaysia and Indonesia. It has set up institutions such as Teachers College of Chinese Language and Confucius Institute in UK, Sri Lanka and Rwanda.

CNU recruits more than 600 overseas students every year. It has set up Teachers College of Chinese Language in Indonesia and UK, and implemented the 2+2 education system. It has also founded Confucius Institutes in Rwanda, Sri Lanka and Britain. Students of CNU have successfully exchanged to Russia Voronezh Normal University, Japan Hiroshima Culture University and Japan Shinshu University several times. And CNU has successfully organized different Chinese culture winter/ summer camp for years, in which the number of overseas students amount to several thousands.

CNU attaches much importance to overseas students' education and administration in a way of classified teaching and human-based management, insisting on classification teaching and humanization management. International Students Office enjoys much popularity with overseas students as their home in China, and gets the widely acclaimed by them. CNU provide international students a better integration of education, carrying out the convergence management and teaching. CNU took the lead in Chongqing to set up International College of Chinese Language and Culture, providing better education and administration for Chinese language training students. The college offers favorable learning environment for overseas students as much as possible with small-sized classes and special tutoring.

CNU will actively promote the campus as the teaching-research normal universities of distinctive features, the front rank in western areas and be of great influence in China!

Information for Prospective Overseas Students

Approved by the Ministry of Education, P.R. China, Chongqing Normal University (hereafter as CNU) enrolls overseas students every year. Short-term programs are available year around. There are two semesters for both long-term training and degree programs students (Fall semester: September to January; Spring Semester: February to July). Students who want to study at CNU should apply at least one month in advance.

I . Length of the Programs:

1. Short-Term Training Programs: 2 to 10 weeks.
2. Long-Term Training Programs: one semester to two semesters.
3. Undergraduate programs: 3-6 years.
5. Postgraduate programs: 2-5 years.

II . Courses (Other information please refer to admission of professional directory)

III. Admission Requirements:

1. Applicants for Long-term and Short-term Training Programs

Age: Between 18 and 55, in sound health.

2. Applicants for Undergraduate Study

Age: Between 18 and 55.

Language Proficiency: A certified high school diploma for bachelor's degree applicants is required, having achieved the required level of New HSK (the Chinese Proficiency Test) level 4

or above. Malaysia Chinese senior high school graduates need not submit this kind of achievements.

3. Applicants for Postgraduate Study

Age: Between 18 and 55.

Requirements: A certified bachelor degree for Master's degree applicants is required; two letters of recommendation by associate professors or professors (original copy or scanned copy), having achieved the required level of New HSK (the Chinese Proficiency Test) level 5 or above.

IV. Application Procedures:

1. Applicants outside of China shall contact the International Students Office, at Chongqing Normal University or visit <http://international.cqnu.edu.cn> to download and fill in Admission Application Form in Chongqing Normal University.
2. Health Examination: completed Physical Examination Form for Foreigners (available at <http://international.cqnu.edu.cn>) together with the original copy (lab copy of AIDS, sexually transmitted diseases, type B Hepatitis and X-ray) of the health examination from hospitals with red stamp.
3. Diploma and transcripts of the most advanced studies.
4. Applicants shall post all the application documents and registration fee RMB 320 to the International Students Office of CNU. (Application Form for Admission can be sent by e-mail.) After approval of all the documents, the International Students Office will send Admission Notice and Visa Application Form to the applicants, with which the applicants shall go to the Chinese embassy or consulate for an X Visa (students' Visa).
5. Applicants shall come to the International Students Office of CNU for registering on the required date and hand in all the necessary documents for admission. The documents needed are *Admission Notice*, Passport, *JW202 Form*, *Physical Examination Record for Foreigners*, 4 one-inch passport pictures. All tuition fees must be paid before the semester begins.
6. Overseas students who transfer from another Chinese University to Chongqing Normal University shall finish the Application Form for Admission and send the form, a transferring certificate by the previous school, and other required application documents to the International Students Office, Chongqing Normal University.

V. Reception Service

Free airport or train station pick up service for new students is available upon request in advance.

VII. Scholarship

Chongqing Normal University is a key reception institute of **Chinese Government Scholarship**, **Confucius Institute Scholarship** and **Chongqing Municipal Mayor Scholarship** for overseas students. CNU has also set up **CNU President Scholarship** for those excellent overseas students studying at the University. Welcome to apply for scholarships.

A. Chinese Government Scholarship

1. Application time: January 1 to April 10

2. Basic information of scholarship

Full scholarship

- Exempt from tuition fee and on-campus accommodation;
- Living allowance (3000 RMB per month for postgraduate student; 2500 RMB per month for undergraduate student)
- Fee for Comprehensive Medical Insurance in China;

3. Eligibility

- (1) Applicants should be non-Chinese nationals in good health.
- (2) Applicants should not be a registered student in Chinese universities at the time of application; or be a graduate from Chinese universities for more than one year.
- (3) Applicants for master degree studies must have a bachelor's degree and be under the age of 35; Applicants for Bachelor degree studies must have a bachelor's degree and be under the age of 25

4. Application Materials

Applicants are required to submit application on the website of China Scholarship Council and have the application printed and send it together with other documents required to International Office of Chongqing Normal University. Online Application website:

The applicants must fill in and provide the following materials truly and correctly (one original and three copies).

- (1) Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship (printed by CSC), in Chinese or in English. Applicants are required to submit application on the website of China Scholarship Council and have the application printed. Online Application website:
(<http://laihua.csc.edu.cn/inscholarship/jsp/student/StudentLogin.jsp>) Agency No. of Chongqing Normal University is 10637.

(2) Highest diploma (notarized photocopy). If applicants are university students or already employed, they should also provide documents of being university students or on-post employees. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.

(3) Applicants for master's degree shall provide notarized transcripts for bachelor's degree. Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with translations in Chinese or English.

(4) A study or research plan in Chinese or in English (no less than 800 words).

(5) Applicants shall submit two letters of recommendation in Chinese or English by professors or associate professors.

(6) Applicants for music are requested to submit one cassette recording of the applicants' own work. Applicants for fine arts must submit six color photographs of personal works (two sketches, two color paintings and two other works).

(7) Photocopy of Foreigner Physical Examination Form (printed by Chinese quarantine authority) filled in English. The medical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form.

(8) No criminal record certification.

Application materials will not be returned regardless of the result of application.

B. Confucius Institute Scholarship

1. Application time: March 1 to April 30

2. Basic information of scholarship

1. Scholarship for **Bachelor's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (BTCSOL) Students**

2. Scholarship for **Master's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (MTCSOL) Students**

This category provides a sponsorship for 2 academic years. Applicant should own a bachelor's degree or its equivalent, a minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 5), and a minimum score of 50 in HSKK Test (Intermediate Level). Applicant who is able to provide the employment agreement or certification upon finishing the study from designated working institutions is preferred.

3. Scholarship for **One-Academic-Year Study Students**

4. Scholarship for **One-Semester Study Students**

5. Scholarship for **Four-Week Study Students**

Application is open to applicant who owns a non-Chinese citizenship, aged between 16 and 35, in good health condition, (Applicant is currently working in a Chinese language teaching position shall not exceed the age limit of 45. Undergraduate student shall not exceed the age limit of 20).

6. Scholarship winners are exempt from tuition, accommodation fees, monthly living allowance, and comprehensive insurance for foreign students studying in China. 2500 RMB per month for living allowances are provided for Bachelor's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (BTCSOL) program, One-Academic-Year program, One-Semester program, 3000RMB for Master's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (MTCSOL) program.

3. Eligibility

1. Scholarship for Bachelor's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (BTCSOL) Students

This category provides a sponsorship for 4 academic years. Applicant should hold a high school diploma or above, a minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 3), and a minimum score of 40 in HSKK Test (Intermediate Level).

2. Scholarship for Master's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (MTCSOL) Students

This category provides a sponsorship for 2 academic years. Applicant should own a bachelor's degree or its equivalent, a minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 5), and a minimum score of 50 in HSKK Test (Intermediate Level). Applicant who is able to provide the employment agreement or certification upon finishing the study from designated working institutions is preferred.

3. Scholarship for One-Academic-Year Study Students

This category provides a sponsorship for 11 months. Application is open to Confucius Institute (Classroom) students, overseas Chinese language teachers, Chinese language major students and excellent performers in HSK test. International students who are now studying in China are not eligible for the scholarship. Applicant should have a minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 3), and 60 in HSKK test (Beginner Level). Alternatively, applicant should hold a minimum score of 180 in BCT (A) , and a minimum score of 180 BCT (Speaking).

4. Scholarship for One-Semester Study Students

This category provides a sponsorship for 5 months. Applicant should have no prior experience of studying in China, but have a minimum score of 120 in HSK Test (Level 2), and a minimum score of 40 in HSKK (Beginner Level). Alternatively, applicant should have a minimum score of 100 in BCT (A), and a minimum score of 120 in BCT (Speaking).

5. Scholarship for Four-Week Study Students

This category provides a sponsorship for 4-week study which is mainly focusing on Chinese language. Application is mainly open to Confucius Institute (Classroom) students, excellent performers in HSK test, and outstanding club members of *Confucius Institute Magazine*. Applicant should submit a HSK or BCT score report, and have no prior experience of studying in China.

4. Application Materials

Applicants should log onto the Scholarship website (<http://cis.chinese.cn>), fill out the “Confucius Institute Scholarship Application Form”, and attach the electronic files of the following materials:

1. A scanned copy of the passport photo page. Applicants under the age of 18 shall submit relevant documents of entrusted legal guardians in China.

2. Score reports of the HSK, HSKK or BCT, BCT (Speaking). Winners of the finals of the “Chinese Bridge” Chinese Proficiency Competitions may submit the award certificate and the “Confucius Institute Scholarship Certificate”.

3. Recommendation letter signed by the head of the recommending institutions (please provide objective comments on the applicant, including whether the applicant is a student of Confucius Institute or other identity. Chinese language teachers shall submit an employment verification letter and a reference letter provided by the institutes they work for.)

4. No criminal record certification.

C. Chongqing Municipal Mayor Scholarship

1. Application time: March 1 to April 10

2. Basic information of scholarship

Level of Candidates	Standard (RMB/year)

Undergraduate students	25,000

The coverage of scholarship should be not longer than the normal years for undergraduate/graduate program.

3. Eligibility

(1) Applicants must be non-Chinese in good health.

(2) Applicants for master degree studies must have a bachelor degree, and be under the age of 35.

(3) Applicants for bachelor degree studies must have a high school diploma and be under the age of 25.

4. Application Materials

Applicants are required to submit the following application materials in three sets.

(1) Application form (see Attachment 1)

(2) Highest diploma attained or proof of study (notarized photocopy). Applicants who are students currently studying at Chongqing Normal University shall also provide a Study Certificate and transcripts from Chongqing Normal University. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with translations in Chinese or English.

(3) Transcripts of the most advanced studies (notarized photocopy).

(4) Study plan (written in Chinese or English).

(5) Two letters of recommendation. Applicants for master degree studies shall provide two letters of recommendation by associate professors or professors. Applicants who are students currently studying at Chongqing Normal University shall provide a recommendation letter from the International Administration Office or a teacher in Chongqing Normal University.

(6) Examples of arts and music work (only for the applicants applying for Fine Arts and Music).

(7) Copy of Foreigner Physical Examination Form (for applicants who are currently not studying at Chongqing Normal University) See Attachment 2.

(8) Copy of passport.

(9) No criminal record certification.

D. CNU President Scholarship

1. Application time: April 1 to April 15

3. Eligibility

(1) Applicants should be a registered student for more than one year in CNU at the time of application.

(2) Applicants should not have violated any laws and regulations in China, and excellent in study.

4. Application Materials

Applicants are required to submit the following application materials in three sets.

(1) Application form

(2) Transcripts of the latest academic year.

(3) Study plan (written in Chinese or English).

(4) Two letters of recommendation from teachers in Chongqing Normal University.

(5) No criminal record certification.

VIII. Completion of Education and Graduation

Upon the completion of requirements needed to fulfill a program and passing all required courses, overseas students are eligible for the following:

1. Short-Term/Long-Term training students will be granted a Certificate of Completion of his/her particular program.
2. Degree candidates who have successfully defended his/her dissertation will be granted related Graduation Certificate and Degree Diploma.

IX. Tourism Policy

Chongqing is an ancient and cultural city with unique city architecture on the upper reaches of the Yangtze River in Southwestern China. It is extraordinarily rich in tourism resources. Free trips may be arranged by the University within the city limits. During summer vacations or after the completion of your education on campus, group tours can be scheduled by the university with students' proposals and all expenses incurred will be the personal responsibility of participants.

Fees for International Students of Chongqing Normal University

I . Tuition (Chinese currency):

(1) Short-term Training: 1,600RMB for two weeks, 400RMB per each extra week of training.

(2) Long-term Training of Chinese Language and Culture: 6,400RMB per semester, 12,000RMB per academic year.

(3) Long-term Training of Other Majors: Major training programs are paid according to different majors.

(4) Undergraduate Programs:

13,000 RMB per academic year for liberal arts programs

15,000 RMB per academic year for science programs

17,000 RMB per academic year for arts and physical education programs

(5) Postgraduate Programs:

17,000RMB per academic year for liberal arts programs

19,000RMB per academic year for science programs

21,000RMB per academic year for arts and physical education programs

II. Accommodation Fee (Chinese currency):

Apartments on the new campus (with a bedroom and a bathroom, internet interface, 2 students share one apartment): 2,400RMB per academic year per person.

3. Special Explanation

(1) For CNU scholarship students who must live in the international students apartment or Chinese student apartment.

(2) Those who intend to live in on-campus apartments should reserve 40 days in advance. Overseas students are also allowed to live in off-campus apartments.

III. Fee for Meals

Students can have meals in the Dinning Halls for Chinese students. The students can also cook for themselves. On average, it costs about 20-30RMB per person per day.

IV. Text Books and Miscellaneous Fee: Fee for text books depends on the class schedule.

V. Application Fee: 320RMB, which should be sent to CNU International Students Office together with application form and other required documents for admission.

VI. Visa Fee: 400RMB for X1 visa (6months to 12 months), and 168RMB for X2 visa(less than 6 months. In order to submit all the documents for visa, applicants also need body check in

designated Hospital and visa photo in Chongqing, which may cost 400RMB and 30RMB, respectively.

VII. Insurance Fee: 800RMB for a year. All the long-term international students (half year and above) will buy medical insurance. The reimbursement is subject to Chinese laws and regulation.

VIII. The tuition fee and enrollment fee are non-refundable. Fees are subject to CNU change.

Special Recommendation

Chinese Language Training

Chongqing Normal University is entitled by the Ministry of Education, P.R. China to enroll overseas students. It was designated as one of the first Chinese Language Educational Centers by

the Overseas Chinese Affairs Office of the State Council and is currently the only one in western China. And it was awarded the National Teaching Base for International Promotion of Chinese (Chongqing) by Confucius Institute Headquarters in 2012. International College of Chinese Language and Culture of CNU was established, which focus on overseas Chinese language and culture learning. Taking advantage of CNU outstanding liberal arts and abundant teacher resource, the college provides high-quality teaching and the best choice for foreigners and overseas Chinese to learn the Chinese language and culture in Chongqing.

According to individual Chinese level and study requirement of the students, International College of Chinese Language and Culture offers short-term and long-term Chinese training programs. Enrollment for long-term Chinese training program is February and September yearly, while short-term Chinese training program can start anytime if there is a group of over 10 students.

★ Short-term Chinese training program starts for a group of over 10 students and may last two weeks, three weeks or a couple of months. The teaching content is mainly practical mandarin courses aiming at develop the abilities of listening, speaking, reading and writing. Compulsory courses include Oral Chinese 301, Characters, Listening and Speaking, Elementary Intensive Chinese, etc. Optional courses include Chinese Calligraphy, Chinese Cuisine, Taiji, Paper-cutting, Chinese Folk Songs, etc. The study period is determined by the students themselves according to their actual need and Chinese level. In addition, Chinese Language and Culture Tour Program is offered to a group of over 10 students. For this program, the university will organize trips related to Chinese culture after a period of intensive Chinese training to the students. Besides the tuition, the students have also to pay tourism fee which is under the criteria of market quotation. Details of study period and tourism plan can be set through consultation between the students and university in advance.

★ Long-term Chinese training program lasts one or two years and offers elementary, intermediate and advanced classes, the class-size of which is no more than 15 students.

Elementary Class: Main compulsory courses cover Pinyin, Basic Chinese Reading and Writing, Oral and Listening. After completion of study, the students will obtain elementary abilities of listening, speaking, reading and writing.

Intermediate Class: Main compulsory courses cover Intermediate Chinese Reading, Intermediate Chinese Listening and Speaking, writing and cultural courses. After completion of study, the students will master about 3,000 frequent words and the abilities of ordinary writing and complicated listening, speaking and reading. Their HSK level will reach Level 4.

Advanced Class: Main compulsory courses cover Advanced Chinese Reading, Advanced Oral Chinese, Modern Chinese Grammar and Rhetoric, Chinese Culture and Geography. After completion of study, the students will master about 4,000-5,000 frequent words and expressions, 120-240 frequent grammatical items, HSK level reaching Level 5.

For the students of long-term Chinese training program, CNU will arrange them into specific classes according to their Chinese levels.
