

Troy University Confucius Institute (CIT) held 2016 Spring HSK and YCT Tests

Chinese language students from around Alabama participated in written Chinese language proficiency tests over the past week.

Students from the Birmingham and Montgomery area took tests to demonstrate their proficiency among 9 levels of HSK and YCT tests.

Students said that meeting a goal of passing a test motivated them to succeed.

“I find that taking a test is an excellent way to motivate myself in Chinese learning,” said a LAMP student.

The tests, administered by CIT teachers, were administered to Baldwin County schools, LAMP school, Indian Springs School between February 20, and February 27.

The students expressed confidence in their scores and so did the CIT teachers, as students have achieved a 95% passing rate in the past.

The Oral Chinese proficiency test, HSKK, will be held on March. 19 in both Troy and Montgomery campuses, which will be the first oral Chinese test conducted by CIT.
