On September 22, 2016, Chinese Corner opened again in fall semester 2016 in Bibb Graves Hall of Confucius Institute on Troy Campus. The theme for the corner is *Chinese Knotting*. The presenter, Wenjuan Cheng, introduced the definition and historical origins of Chinese knots. And combined with pictures, she also introduced seven basic Chinese knots, namely, Double Coin Knot、 Button Knot、 Million Characters Knot、 Cross Knot、 Auspicious knot、 Ping Knot and Panchang Knot. With Teresa Teng's beautiful song as background music, students did some simple exercises on Auspicious knot and Ping Knot. With the Ping Knotting principles, Ms. Cheng showed students how to weave a bracelet and dragonfly. After the short-term exercises, all the students can weave the beautiful bracelet by themselves.
