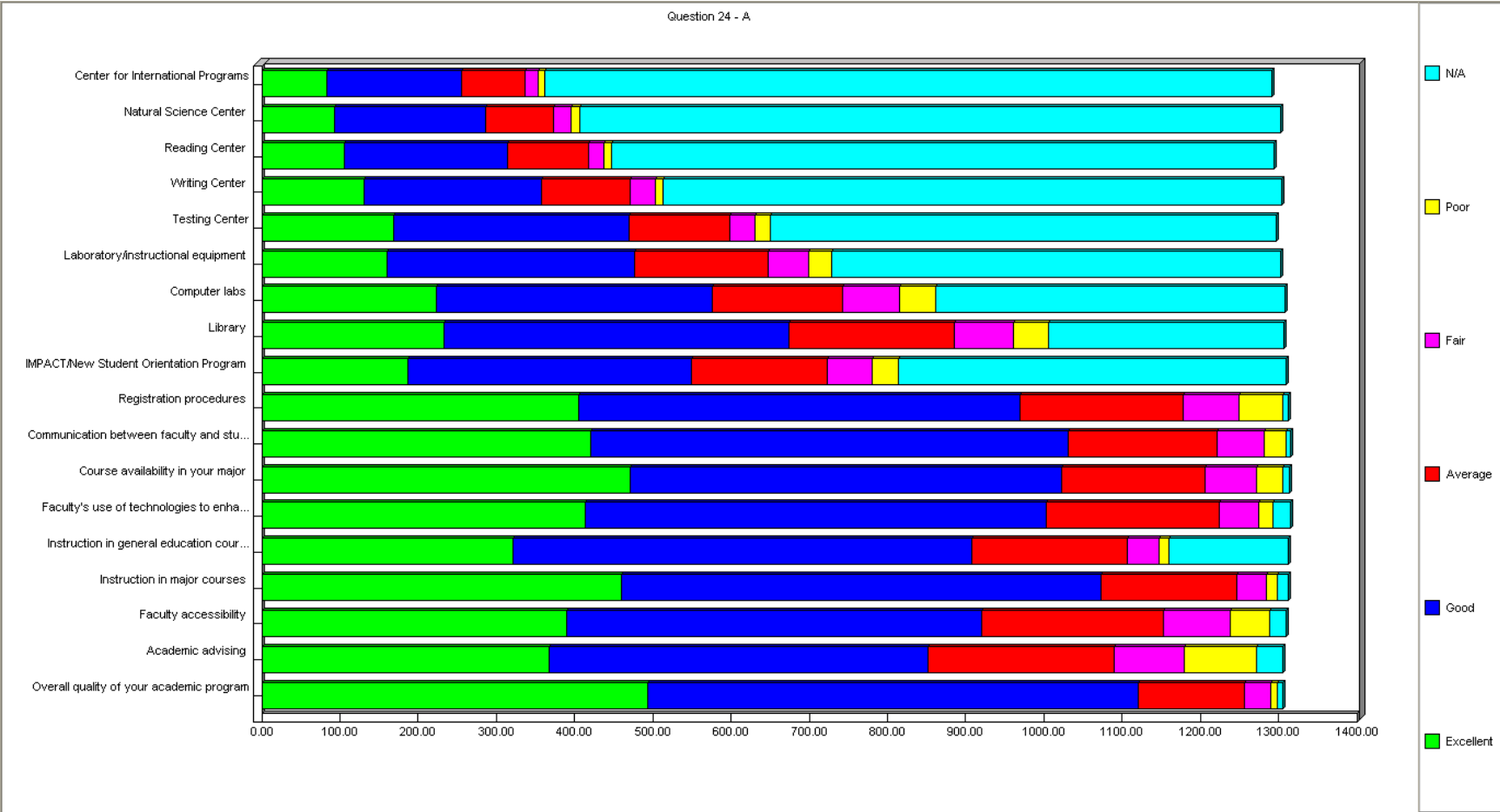

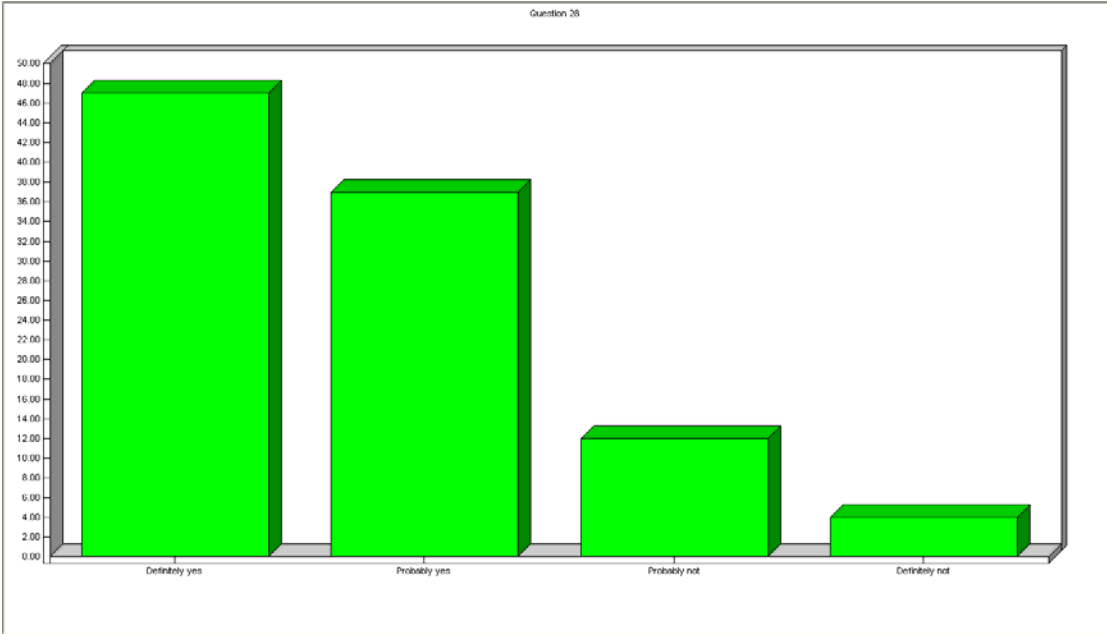

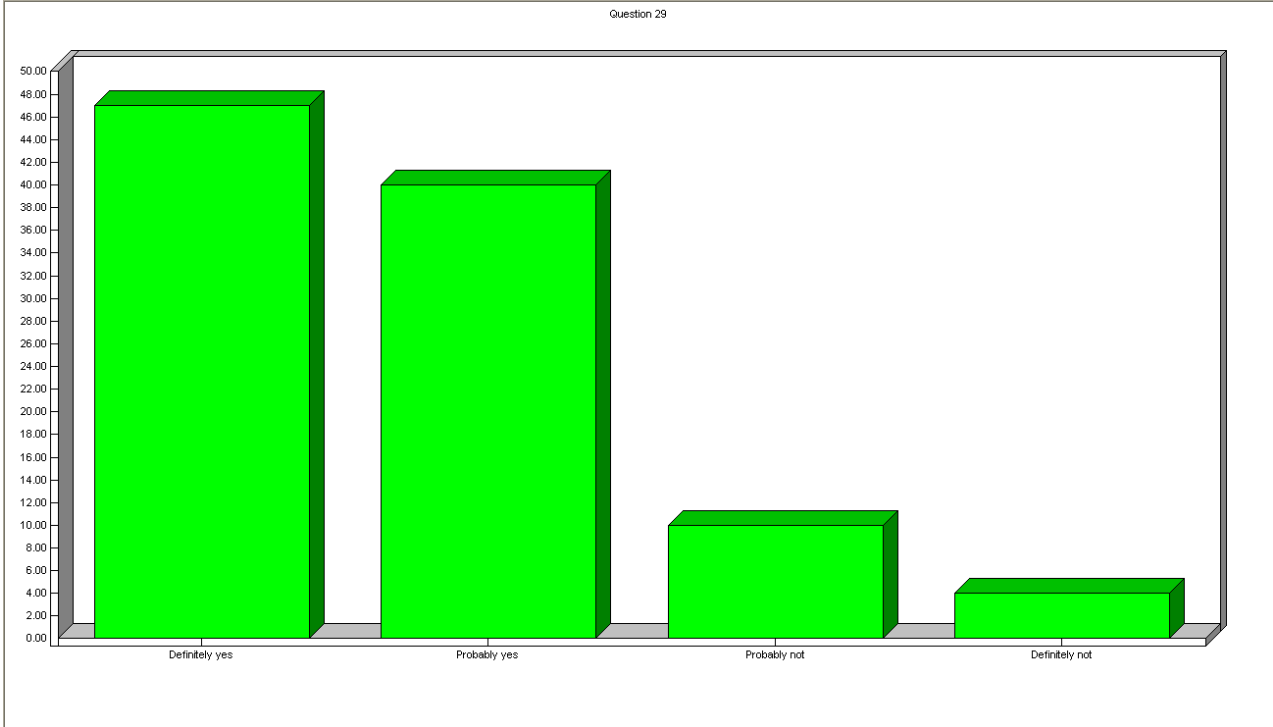

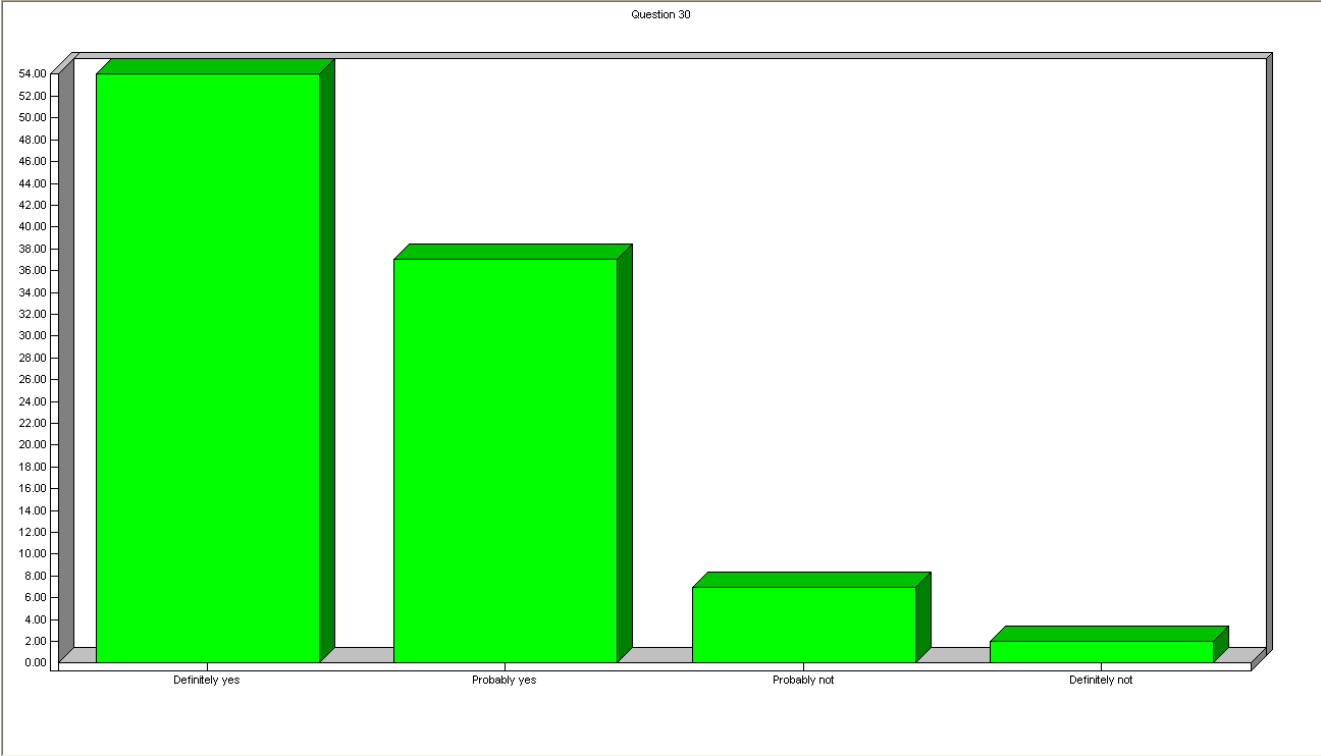

Question 29: If you could start college over, would you attend Troy University again?



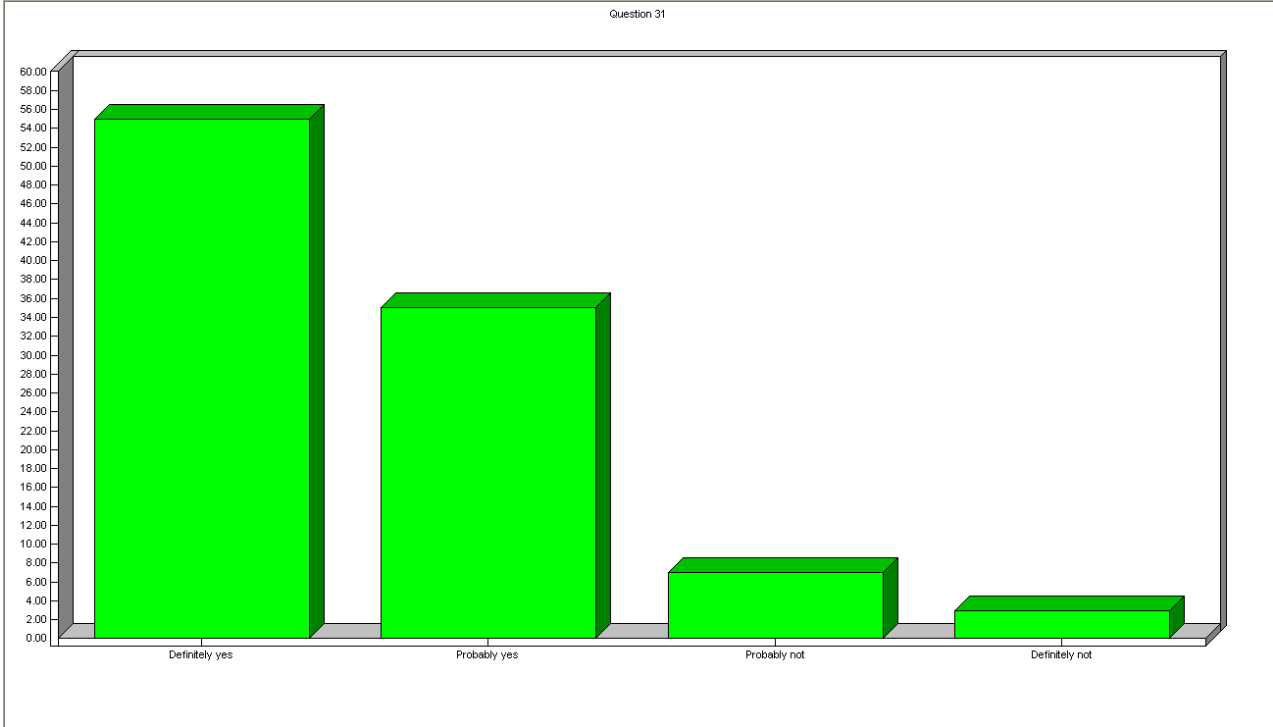

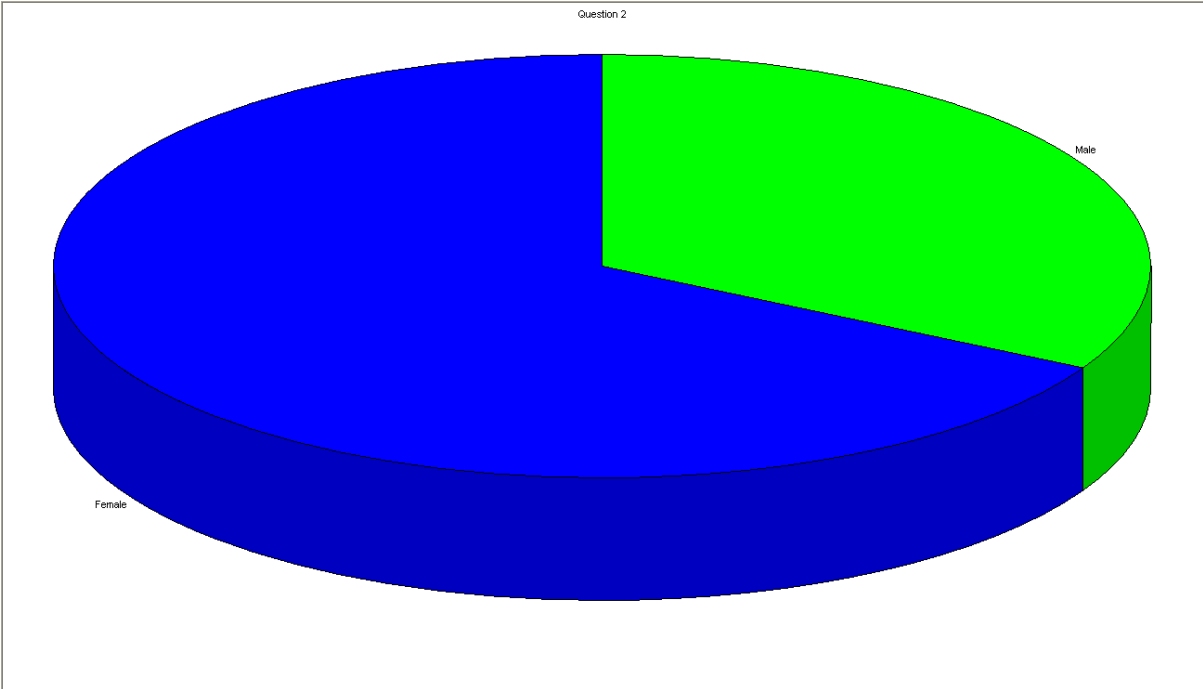

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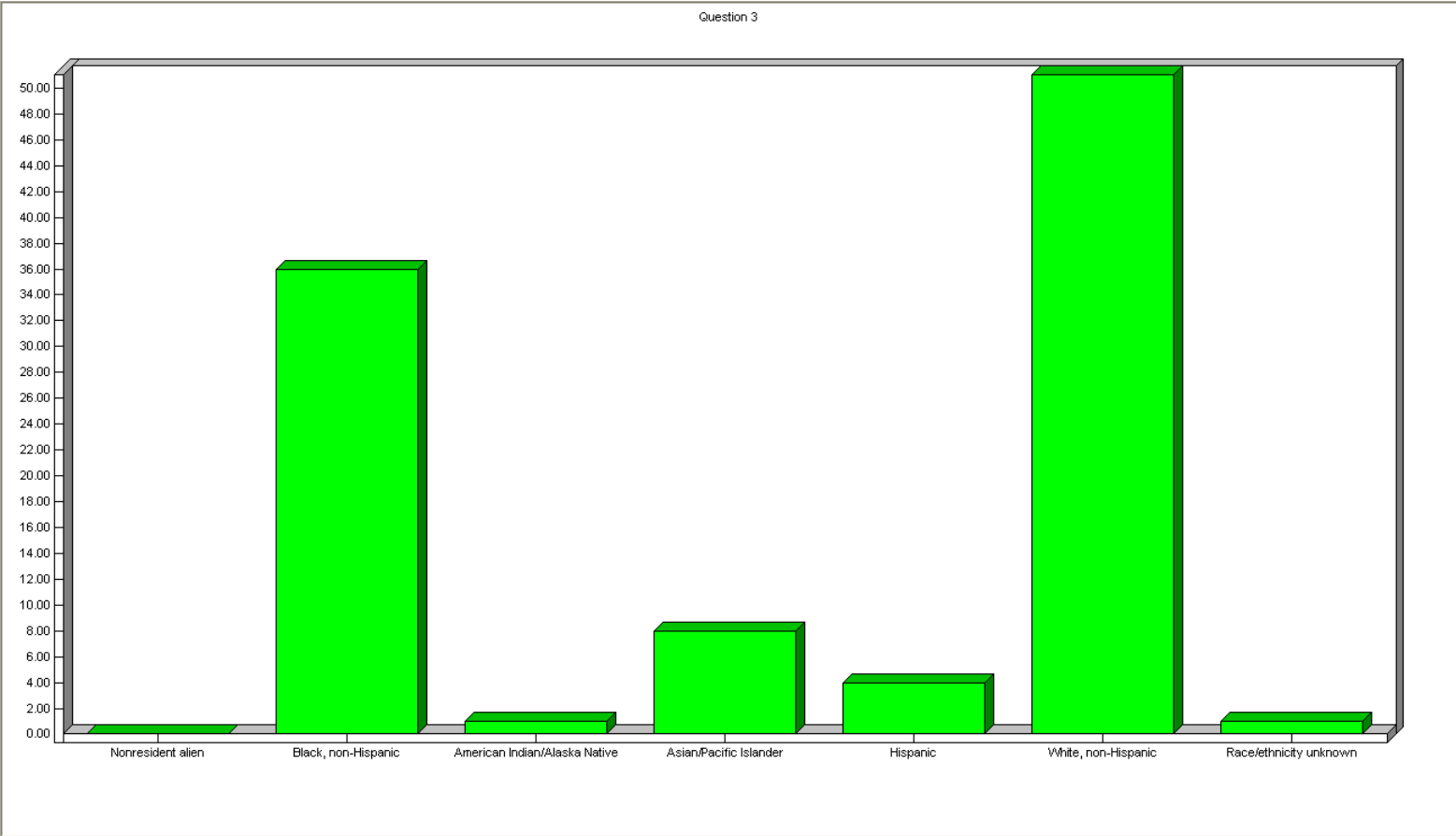

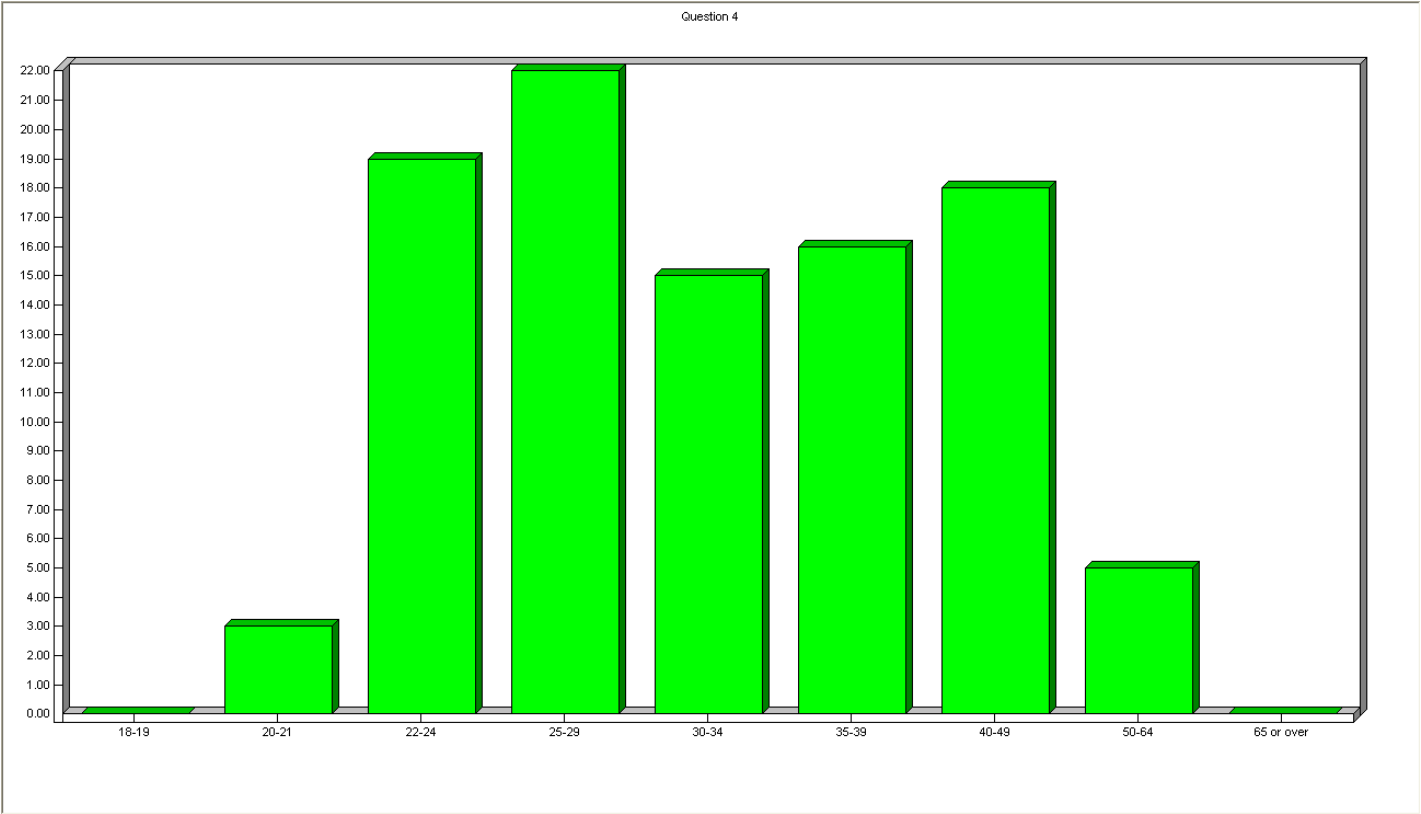

DEMOGRAPHIC CHARTS**



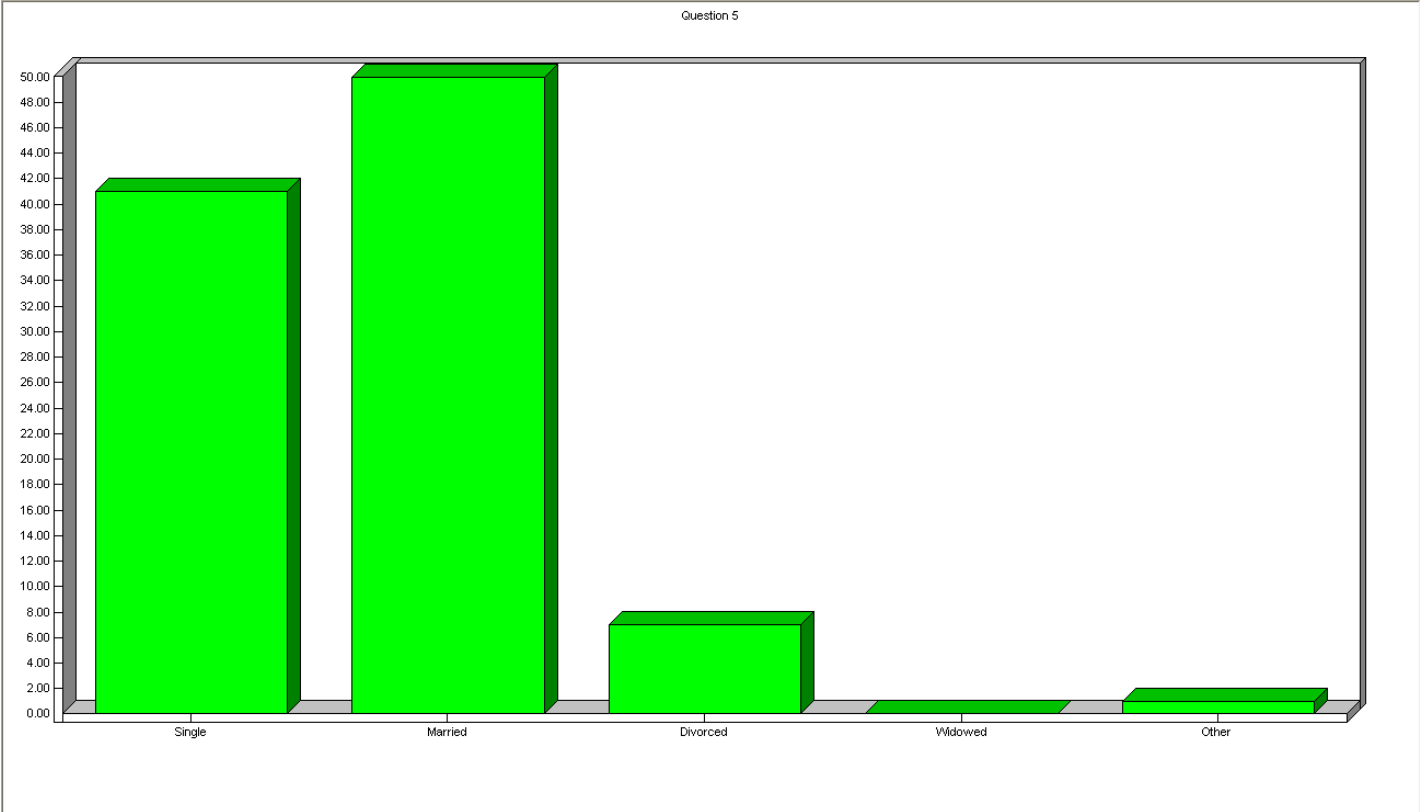
