Who will instruct?

Instructors will be Teacher-Consultants of the Wiregrass Writing Project (an affiliate of the National Writing Project). The consultants are part of a vital, growing network of teachers nationwide who are developing and practicing the most effective instructional strategies in thinking and writing. An anthology featuring selected contributions from all participants will be published at the end of each workshop. Students and their school libraries will receive copies.

Who may participate?

Interested students entering grades 2-8, who have a sincere desire to become better thinkers and writers, should enroll. (Teachers who wish to participate with students in a think-write learning model should register for the appropriate workshop in the *At Your Service* summer brochure, which lists area-wide summer workshops sponsored by the Southeast Regional Inservice Center. Twenty CEU hours will given to teachers for the week.)
