

Homecoming Queen Court Application

Troy University female campus students may be nominated for Homecoming Queen only by on-campus student organizations. A nomination fee of \$25 per candidate must be paid by the nominating organization by 4 P.M. on Tuesday, September 9, 2014. Only one candidate may be nominated per organization.

Requirements:

- The candidate must have an overall minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75.
- The candidate must have completed at least 30 hours at the Troy University main campus, and must be in good standing with the University.
- The nominating organization must submit a complete application, along with a headshot of the candidate by the listed date (official headshots will be taken at a later date). **These headshots must be sent to sgavote@troy.edu by 4 P.M. Sept. 9.**
- The nominating organization must also provide a short essay (300 words or less) explaining why its candidate deserves a Homecoming Court nomination. **This document is due by 4 P.M. on Sept. 9 to sgavote@troy.edu.**
- All candidates must have a service-project oriented platform in order to run for Homecoming Court. If elected as Homecoming Queen, you must carry out your service project within one year of your crowning as Queen, with assistance from the SGA. This platform cannot be the same as your organization's philanthropy or other service project. **The platform must be submitted by 4 P.M. on Sept. 9 to sgavote@troy.edu.**

Court elections will take place on Wednesday, September 24, from 8 A.M. – 6 P.M. in TC 215. The Court will be announced at the Troy vs. Texas St. Sept. 27 at 7 P.M. All candidates will be required to attend a meeting on Tuesday, September 9, 2014 at 8:30 P.M. in Patterson 103. The five (5) candidates who are voted onto Homecoming Court will then interview with a selected panel of judges for the remainder of the Homecoming Queen selection process. The percentages for Homecoming Queen are as follows:

- 60% popular vote
- 40% interview
