Program Description

STARTALK is a government initiative to increase the number of Americans learning critical need languages. The STARTALK program pays tuition for high school students to learn Chinese language and culture at Troy University during the summer time. The National Foreign Language Centre at the University of Maryland has awarded the STARTALK grant to select schools across the nation, including many key universities. High school students (including incoming 9th to 12th graders, as well as newly graduated high school students) learn communicative ability as well as cultural awareness from experienced native language teachers in Troy University's lively and task-based classes. One of TROY-STARTALK 2018's benefits is that there is no other cost than a \$50.00 application fee for this two-week long residential language learning program.
